

## EMBARKATION PROCEDURE FOR THE MV HELENA DEPARTING CAPE TOWN

Embarkation at Cape Town will take place at **2pm 14:00** on the day of departure.

The meeting point for passengers is the Mission to Seamen where you will be met by the Cape Town agent. Passport and tickets will be checked at this point and then passengers will then be escorted to the immigration office. Once cleared passengers will be taken directly to the vessel and will no longer be allowed to go ashore. Visitors are also not allowed on the ship.

Cabin baggage allowances are 1 x 23kg suitcases per person. Total hold baggage allowed per person is 1 cubic metre and must not exceed 250 kg.

All passengers require 2 blank pages in their passports and the passport needs to be valid for **6 months** from the date of re-entry into the country of final destination. Temporary passports are not allowed.

Please check your government website for visa requirements for South Africa.

Flip flops and high heeled sandals are not allowed to be worn when embarking and disembarking the ship at any of the ports of call.



## DISEMBARKATION PROCEDURE FOR THE MV HELENA ARRIVING CAPE TOWN

The MV Helena will arrive at the appointed berth on day of arrival. If Immigration do not clear passengers on board th	ıe
vessel then they will be transported by courier bus to the immigration office.	

Passengers can be collected the Mission to Seamen's once immigration has been finalised.

The Cape Town agent will be advised of the MV Helena's estimated time of arrival and a notice will be issued on the website.

An AW Ship Management employee will be in attendance at the Mission to Seamens to assist you and answer any queries.

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
