

DISEMBARKATION PROCEDURE FOR THE MV HELENA ARRIVING ST HELENA

Upon arrival at St Helena passengers must provide proof of their medical insurance with a minimum cover of £250,00.0	0.
Policy should cover aero medical evacuation.	

Passport validity must be at least 6 months and have a minimum of 2 free pages.

A return ticket and proof of accommodation booked on the island/letter of invitation is required to be shown.

There is a £20.00 landing fee to be paid by all visitors. Certain nationalities require a visa, please visit the St Helena tourism website for more information - http://sthelenatourism.com/getting-here/general-travel-information

Flip flops and high heeled sandals are not allowed to be worn when embarking and disembarking the ship at any of the ports of call.
