

DISEMBARKATION PROCEDURE FOR THE MV HELENA ARRIVING ASCENSION ISLAND

It is currently Ascension Island Government policy not to issue entry visas to nationals of the following countries: Belarus, China, Egypt, Hong Kong, Iran, Libya, Macau, North Korea, Russia, Syria, Taiwan, Ukraine, and Vietnam.

All visitors will need to apply for a visa at least 14 days before their intended travel, this can be obtained via the Ascension Island website - <https://www.ascension-island.gov.ac/entry-visas/>

Upon arrival at Ascension Island passengers must provide proof of their medical insurance with a minimum cover of £250,00.00. Policy should cover aero medical evacuation.

A return ticket and proof of accommodation booked on the island is required to be shown.

Passport validity must be at least **6 months** and have a minimum of 2 free pages.

Landing Fees range from £10 to £20 and apply to all visitors whether they are formally leaving the vessel or only intend a few hours sightseeing.

Flip flops and high heeled sandals are not allowed to be worn when embarking and disembarking the ship at any of the ports of call.
