1. Law Society

- ❖ The LSO is continuing to work with the Banks and the Federal government on financial services matters - especially those related to the Real Estate bar.

3. Privacy and Security of ZOOM meetings

- ❖ Call participants were reminded of Section 136 of the Courts of Justice Act with allows for recordings of proceedings.
- ❖ All virtual meetings are run by the Courts and the Courts serve as video conference hosts and all parties, at the beginning of the proceedings, are made aware that the sessions are being recorded and are asked to agree.
- ❖ Permission for any other party to record the session would be authorized by the host. Participants are by invitation of the Courts only and participants can be removed at any time by the host.
- ❖ All video technology is using the highest industry standards regarding privacy and security.
