By creating a proper profile it helps others in the Conquer Local Community understand who they are talking to. Username should consist of your first and last name and which organization you belong to.

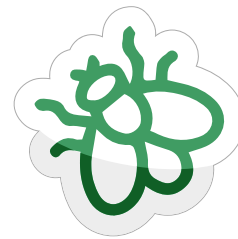
