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# General Information on the Application for Preliminary Analysis for a Change of Name

# What should you know?

A preliminary analysis enables the Directeur de l'état civil to verify a person's eligibility for a change of name application, and to determine whether that step is appropriate to his or her situation.

If you or the person concerned by the request for preliminary analysis are eligible for a change of name application, the Directeur de l'état civil will send you, by mail, all the documents necessary to apply. Otherwise, we will inform you of the solution appropriate to the situation.

Eligibility for a change of name application does not mean that the change of name will be authorized by the Directeur de l'état civil.

#### Who can apply?

You can apply for a change of name for yourself if you are 14 years of age or over, are a Canadian citizen and have been domiciled in Québec for at least one year.

You can apply to change the name of a person under 18 years of age if you are the father, mother or tutor, as long as that person is a Canadian citizen and has been domiciled in Québec for at least one year.

#### Notification and objection

Except for a compelling reason, the Directeur de l'état civil cannot grant the name change of a person under 14 years of age if the father and mother or tutor, if applicable, have not been notified of the application or if they object.

Similarly, except for a compelling reason, the Directeur de l'état civil cannot grant the name change of a person between 14 and 17 years of age if the father and mother, tutor, if applicable, or the person concerned have not been notified of the application. The same is true if one of these people objects to the application, unless the request is to add to the surname one of the surnames of the father or mother, in which case the right to object is reserved to the person between 14 and 17 years of age.

#### Application for one or more children under 18 years of age

If the application is for more than one child, you must complete a form for each child. Complete all of the sections of the first form and sections 1, 3 and 4 only of each additional form, if the information for the other sections is the same.

#### Person born outside Québec

If you or the person concerned by the application for preliminary analysis were born outside Québec and the birth is not entered in the Québec register of civil status, you must apply to the Directeur de l'état civil to have the act of birth inserted in the register so the application for a change of name can be processed.

In that case, complete the form Application for Insertion of an Act of Civil Status Made Outside Québec into the Québec Register of Civil Status. You can obtain that form at one of our service counters, on our website or by contacting us.

You must submit that form to us, along with the required documents, in the same envelope as the Application Preliminary Analysis for a Change of Name.

Furthermore, if the person to whom the application pertains is eligible to apply for a change of name and was born outside Canada, the Directeur de l'état civil will require a copy of both sides of his or her Canadian Citizenship Card or Certificate when submitting the change of name application. If you are not in possession of this document, you must apply to obtain a Canadian Citizenship Certificate from Citizenship and Immigration Canada before submitting the change of name application.
