

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Is there study material available for the exam?

There is study material available on the Fire Department website:

Can I bring food/drinks in the testing room?

No food or drinks are allowed in the testing room. The candidate will need to finish or throw away any food or drink before signing in. Candidates will be allowed to get water from the water fountain in the testing room.

Will there be a place to check in items not allowed in the testing room?

No, please refer to the list of items allowed in the testing room and leave everything else at home. The City of San Antonio will not be held responsible for lost, stolen or misplaced items.

Can I save a seat for my friend if we sign in and register at different times?

No, applicants will be seated in the order that they register and enter the testing room.

Can I bring a sweater/jacket to the exam?

Yes, but it must be worn or hung on the back of your chair for the entire exam. You will want to dress comfortably and be prepared to adapt if the room temperature changes.

Can I talk with my friend while we wait for the test to begin?

Once you enter the testing room there will be no talking allowed.

Can I leave the testing room once I have signed in and been seated?

No, once a candidate has registered and entered the testing room, they will not be able to leave the testing room. If a candidate leaves the testing room, they will not be able to reenter to test.

How many people will be taking the test with me?

The San Antonio Fire Department tests 1,500 to 2,000 applicants for each firefighter trainee examination.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

When will I receive my score and find out the next step of the process?

Scores will be posted on the SAFD Recruiting website in 3 to 4 weeks. Scores will only be announced through the SAFD Recruiting website. Additionally, any additional next steps and instructions of the hiring process will be communicated through the SAFD Recruiting website. It is your responsibility to monitor the SAFD Recruiting website regularly so that deadlines & steps are not overlooked. Any required step or deadline that isn't adhered to can and will result in a disqualification and removal from any additional processing for the duration of the testing eligibility list.

What type of identification must I bring to the test?

We will accept any ID that has a photo and your name printed on it, including but not limited to:

- Driver License (Including temporary licenses)
- State Issued ID Card
- Military ID
- Student ID
- Credit Card (With Photo)
- Employee Badge
- Passport
