How to Enable FTP Support in Chrome

In Chrome 81, FTP support is disabled by default, but you can enable it using the **# enable-ftp** flag.

- Open Chrome and type "chrome://flags" in the address bar.
- Once in the flags area, type "enable-ftp" in the search bar stating "search flags".
- When you see the "Enable support for FTP URLs" option tap where it says "Default".
- Tap "Enable" option.
- Hit "Relaunch Now" option at the bottom of the page.
- Chrome will relaunch and the Chrome will start supporting FTP.

Restore FTP in Firefox 88 and 89

- 1. Load about:config in the Firefox address bar.
- 2. Confirm that you will be careful.
- 3. Search for network. ftp. enabled.
- 4. Set the value to TRUE by double-clicking on the line, or with a left-click on the toggle icon.
