

### **How to Enable FTP Support in Chrome**

In Chrome 81, FTP support is disabled by default, but you can enable it using the # **enable-ftp** flag.

- Open Chrome and type “**chrome://flags**” in the address bar.
- Once in the flags area, type “**enable-ftp**” in the search bar stating “search flags”.
- When you see the “**Enable support for FTP URLs**” option tap where it says “**Default**”.
- Tap “**Enable**” option.
- Hit “**Relaunch Now**” option at the bottom of the page.
- Chrome will relaunch and the Chrome will start supporting FTP.

### **Restore FTP in Firefox 88 and 89**

1. Load about:config in the Firefox address bar.
2. Confirm that you will be careful.
3. Search for network. ftp. enabled.
4. Set the value to TRUE by double-clicking on the line, or with a left-click on the toggle icon.
