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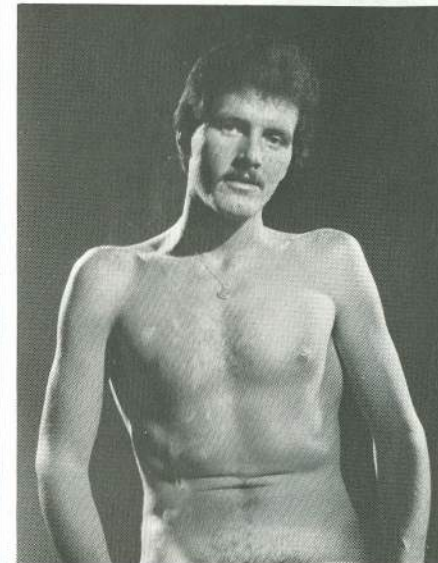
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Shown above and on the cover this issue is Danny, a waiter at the Old Plantation in Houston. The photos were snapped by Algren.



And that's about it for now. Have a great holiday! See ya after it's all over. (Maybe we can get together and share hangovers.) All for now.

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
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ANSWERS BY ADAM

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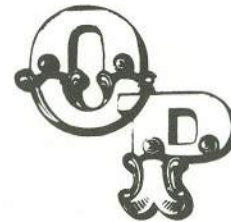
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Life With Vera

"Not manslaughter. Mouse-slaughter," Vera mused.

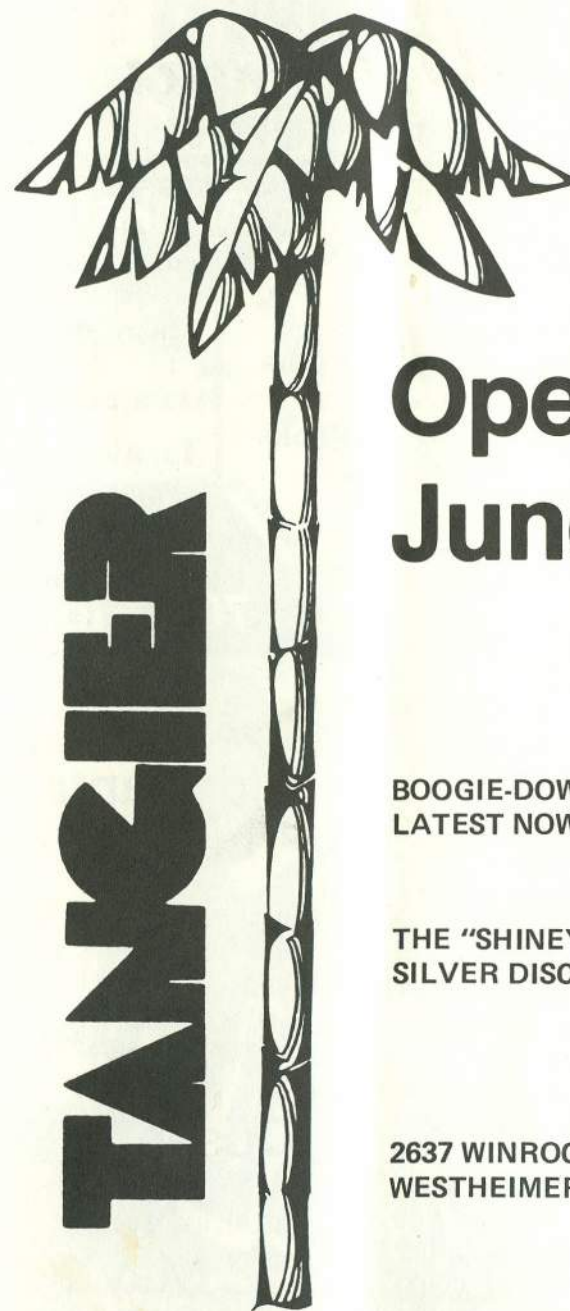
"This is no time for cheap humor. Honestly, it's getting so that I can't go anywhere with you without risk of my own sanity!" Burt shouted.
