

















# 0+3 Quarantine Arrangements for Inbound Persons from Overseas Places and Taiwan



## Rapid Antigen Test (RAT)\*

## PCR-based nucleic acid tests\*

<b>Before departure</b>	 <p>Conducted within 24 hours prior to the scheduled time of departure with a negative result (can be self-administered or by professional swab sampling)</p>		<p><b>Complete the online Health Declaration Form</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Declaration of pre-departure RAT result</li> <li>Non-Hong Kong residents aged 12 or above must fulfill vaccination requirement</li> <li>All persons fulfilling vaccination requirement should declare vaccination records to obtain Provisional Vaccine Pass</li> </ul> 
<b>At check-in</b>			<p><b>Boarding requirement(s) for verification by airlines</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Present <b>green Health Declaration QR code</b> (a downloadable version of the QR code, a screen shot or a printout)</li> </ul> 
<b>Day 0 (day of arrival at HK)</b>		 <p>Undergo specimen collection for PCR-based nucleic acid test at the Airport under "test-and-go" arrangement</p>	<p><b>Medical surveillance</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Observe <b>Medical Surveillance conditions</b></li> <li><b>Amber Code restrictions</b> under <b>Vaccine Pass</b></li> <li>Daily <b>RATs, confirm negative results before leaving residence#</b></li> <li>Login to the <b>Medical Surveillance System</b> to record RAT results and health status</li> <li><b>PCR nucleic acid test</b> on <b>Day 2^#</b></li> <li>Those consecutively tested negative can complete medical surveillance with Amber Code restrictions ending at 9 a.m. of Day 3</li> </ul>

<b>Day 3</b>			<p><b>Self-monitoring</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Monitor health condition and take body temperature twice daily</li> <li>Take appropriate personal disease prevention measures, wear a mask and maintain hand hygiene</li> <li>Daily <b>RATs, confirmed negative results before leaving residence#</b></li> <li>Login to the <b>Medical Surveillance System</b> to record RAT results and health status</li> <li><b>PCR nucleic acid tests</b> on <b>Days 4 and 6^#</b></li> </ul>

### The handling arrangements for persons tested positive will be aligned with that for local cases

- Vaccine Pass will be switched to Red Code
- Please provide information to the Centre for Health Protection through the online platforms (for **nucleic acid tests** or **RATs**)
- If the household environment is not suitable for isolation or the original hotel is not available for on-site isolation, inbound persons tested positive would be sent to Community Isolation Facility or Community Isolation Hotel

\* except inbound persons aged below three years old

^ Inbound persons aged three years old or above on the date of arrival at Hong Kong have to undergo PCR-based nucleic acid testing by professional swab sampling at **Community Testing Centres** or **mobile specimen collection stations** (for free), or at **recognised local medical testing institutions** (self-paid), as specified in the relevant testing requirement above

# Inbound persons must keep the photos of their RAT results and SMS of their PCR nucleic acid test results in case of compliance checking.
