

### HOUSTON MAN CHARGED WITH EXPOSING ANOTHER TO HIV THROUGH BITE

*Community Activists Denounce  
Decision by DA's Office to Hold  
Rodney Zwicker Without Bond.*

HOUSTON — Rodney Zwicker, a 33-year-old man formerly involved in AIDS activism in the Houston area, was charged last week with attempting to transmit HIV to another person after an incident in which he allegedly bit a man. He was taken into custody and held without bond.

Community leaders are denouncing both the fact that the charge was filed against Zwicker and the decision to hold him without bond.

The crime Zwicker is charged with is a third-degree felony. The District Attorney's office stated that no bond had been set because of prior offenses on Zwicker's record.

On the night the alleged assault took place, Zwicker, 33, and his companion apparently became engaged in a dispute outside their apartment. Their landlord intervened, setting up a confrontation during which, the plaintiff charges, Zwicker bit him on the hands and fingers.

The law under which Zwicker has been charged is rarely used. Activist Ray Hill explained that several years ago, gay activists became aware that the Texas Legislature was considering passing a law that would criminalize the intentional spread of HIV. Fearing that such a law would create new opportunities for abuse by law enforcement agencies, the activists, with the help of Glen Maxey (then lobbyist for the Lesbian/Gay Rights Lobby of Texas) managed to get the current, less objectionable statute onto the books.

Hill said that an assault of the type Zwicker has been charged with is a very complex type of offense to prosecute.

Under the provisions of the law, "you'd

have to have visible blood in your saliva; you'd have to know that you had visible blood in it; and you'd have to intentionally bite someone with the express purpose of giving them HIV infection."

"So there's a lot that has to be proven to make this [kind of] offense stick," he added.

Hill added that the decision to hold Zwicker without bond was in effect a punitive measure and very unfair, and that it did not fit the pattern in such felony cases.

Zwicker remained in jail at press time. He is being represented by a court-appointed attorney.

The consensus of medical opinion is that transmission of HIV through biting is extremely unlikely, in part because saliva contains substances that deactivate the virus.

### 'CLUB OCTOPUS' COMES TO DALLAS

*Members Host Parties to Raise  
Funds for Fight Against AIDS.*

DALLAS — Looking for something fun to do during the "dog days" of summer? Why not join the C.O.D. and become a Head Octopus!

C.O.D. stands for Club Octopus Dallas, whose members throw a series of parties throughout the year. The idea is to raise money through donations from guests. According to club rules, the host or hostess gets to decide the time, place, date and format of each party, but fund-raisers must be held during the months of August, September or October.

"A similar organization was started in Austin over three years ago, and they have raised more than \$100,000. Some of their most successful parties have included a volleyball tournament, a dessert contest with celebrity judges and a riverboat cruise," Ron Maddox told TWT NEWS.

Leaders of the Club, known as Head Octopi, must recruit other people to serve as the "arms" of the Octopus. Then the arms find other people to host the parties and assist as needed.

"This structure allows the Club to be big in terms of its fund-raising efforts, but keeps the amount of work that any one person has to commit to as small as possible," Maddox added.





## HOUSTON, NATIONAL LEADERS MEET TO BEGIN PLANNING RESPONSE TO GOP

*Draw up List of Major Issues, Agree on Further Meetings.*

HOUSTON — A small group of people representing a broad spectrum of local gay/lesbian and other human rights groups gathered in Houston last week to begin coordinating a response to the Republican National Convention, being held here August 17-20.

In town to help facilitate the gathering were Robert Bray, Public Information Director of the National Gay & Lesbian Task Force [NGLTF]; B.C. Craig of NGLTF; and Ruth Finklestein, Director of Policy for New York's Gay Men's Health Crisis.

Also attending the meeting were representatives of the Houston Urban League, the National Organization for Women and the All People's Congress.

Several participants expressed the view that the Republican Party is most vulnerable on the issue of reproductive choice, and that human rights groups should therefore make that issue their primary rallying point. Others said that AIDS and lesbian/gay rights are equally important, though there was some disagreement over which of the two should take precedence.

There was also discussion over the relative merits of narrowly-focused and more broad-based actions.

Gay & Lesbian Political Caucus President Chris Bacon stressed that organizers should take into account members of the local community who are not politically active and might hesitate to engage in protest actions.

"You need to have an event that makes people feel they are a part of it, one that is less threatening for people who don't normally take part in civil disobedience."

Suzanne Anderson said she believed it would more effectively impress the Republicans if rights groups coalesced to make a big initial statement.

Don Sanders, National Director of American Gay Atheists, said his group would focus on past statements by President George Bush that atheists cannot be considered patriots or good citizens.

Bray raised the possibility of holding a "unity" event that would bring together all the groups involved. He also stressed the importance of settling on three or four broad issues to ensure the widest possible participation.

The participants agreed to hold further meetings on a weekly basis, and concluded the session by drawing up a list of major positions around which to organize a response to the GOP, including health care; reproductive choice; human/civil rights, justice and equality; economic justice/jobs; and violence against gays, lesbians and women in general.

## 'VOICES FOR LIFE' ALBUM FIGHTS AIDS IN HOUSTON

*Proceeds from Album Sales to Help Area Service Agencies.*

HOUSTON — Scott Evans was returning to Houston after a friend's funeral last January when he decided he "had to do something" about AIDS. What he did was form a foundation, Voices For Life, assemble a board of directors and persuade some of Houston's hottest musical artists to donate their talent towards an album that will benefit agencies offering direct care to people living with AIDS in Houston.

"All the money raised from the sale of this product will remain in Houston, even if the album goes national," Evans said. "We are a 501(c)3 charity; we will disperse funds to the direct care givers by grant." Evans added that he expects the effort to raise \$150,000.

The album will consist of 70 minutes of the best of Houston music, from the Houston Symphony's stringed instruments to Grammy award-winning Little

Joe y La Familia, Christian singer Wayne Nelson, as well as selections by cabaret, zydeco and pop performers. Evans and Ricky Comeaux (of the variety duo Atwood & Comeaux) wrote the opening song, "Shades of Grey" for jazz singer Kellye Gray.

"Most of it is not about AIDS," Evans says, "I wanted most of it to be about hope. That's what we want to dispense when we make our grants, money for services that support the hope of the living."

More than 300 technicians, musicians and their friends gathered June 7 to shoot the first video for *Shades of Grey*, which they hope will gain wide exposure on national TV. All the time, skill and labor have been donated by people who have lost loved ones to AIDS.

"People donated from the heart," Evans said. Houston AIDS researcher Dr. Adan Rios gave \$5,000 to help get the first 10,000 CDs and 5,000 tapes pressed.

Board member Bart Loeser of the AIDS Foundation Houston has been part of the organization since February, and sees it as a tremendous gift to people living with AIDS in Houston. "There's never enough money to help everyone who needs help," he said. "By buying this CD, everyone can help. And the music is fantastic, emotional; it's wonderful."


The album is now half finished, and *Voices For Life* will be available for sale this fall. Almost all the work has been done, but there remains a bit more, and costs are looming. its publication, *Positively Aware*, to community-based AIDS service organizations. AIDS Services of Austin submitted a grant to the Test Positive Aware Network asking to be considered for participation in the program. ASA learned in April that it had been chosen to receive 400 copies of the publication each quarter of this year. The first shipment arrived this month, with subsequent shipments expected in August, October and December.

Articles in each issue range from basic information on AIDS and HIV testing to updates on how to slow the effects of the virus and prevent or treat HIV-related infections.

Also covered are the psychological and social complications of HIV infection, legal and insurance concerns, safer sex guidelines, family issues, lists of HIV/AIDS resources as well the personal stories of of people living with HIV.

*Positively Aware* will be distributed free of charge to people with HIV, their families, service providers and health care professionals through ASA's Wellness Program.

To learn how to receive a copy of *Positively Aware*, contact Wellness Program Coordinator Sylvia Lopez at (512)451-2273.

ASA also has been awarded \$1,000 by the James R. Dougherty, Jr. Foundation of Beeville, Texas for general operating expenses. The grant will be used to help pay ASA's rent.

Established in 1950, the James R. Dougherty, Jr. Foundation supports cultural and other educational programs, health organizations and hospitals as well as youth and social service agencies.

## HIV SERVICES PLANNING COUNCIL ALLOTS ADDITIONAL RYAN WHITE FUNDS

*\$172,000 to Help Dallas PWAs with Rent & Utility Payments.*



will be held at the Bluit-Flowers Center one day a week, at the Martin Luther King Center on two days and the rest of the week through the Community Center.

"We know the need has been there, but it is finally being recognized, and it is receiving public support," Thomas added.

Initially, the AIDS Resource Center had been providing \$13,000 per month for rent and utility assistance. Funds that the city had originally agreed to award the Resource Center were unexpectedly withheld.

"The Resource Center had to cut their budget to only \$1,000 per month, but they have now been able to build that back up to \$2,300 per month," Thomas said.

The Dallas County Welfare Department and the Bethlehem Foundation had also applied to HSPC to distribute the money, but the ARC received the Council's approval. Final OK must come from the County Commissioners next week, but that shouldn't be a problem. Thomas said the commissioners haven't rejected any of the Council's recommendations so far. He added that the commissioners may use every opportunity to express their own opinions, but they have "never turned back a funding approval."

Thomas said that public opinion polls have consistently shown that the greatest need among PWAs is for financial assistance with rent and utilities. Applicants will be evaluated on the basis of their income and personal needs.

Thomas said that the additional funds will be allocated over the next nine months, so the ARC is planning for up to 48 clients per month. Applicants can receive up to \$300 per month for three months for rental assistance, and \$100 per month for up to four months for help in paying their utility bills.

The government often wants to provide funds only to the desolate, Thomas added, but he feels that this type of intermediary assistance is much more cost effective. It is better to help PWAs stay in their own homes than have them be forced to seek public housing, he explained. They can also receive assistance with insurance payments, which help them to continue seeing their private physicians rather than going to public hospitals, Thomas added.

"We are really very happy for our clients, but it has been a rough road to get approval," Thomas said.



**Waiting on AFH**

*The following letter was sent to TWT COMMENT, which solicited a response from AIDS Foundation Houston.—Editor*

Dear TWT:

The first week of May, I went to the AIDS Foundation Houston to apply for services. I applied for a Stone Soup card, which I finally received, and for help with rent and utilities, which I was denied. I was required to provide an incredible amount of personal information, driver's license, disability letter from the Thomas Street Clinic, electric bill, receipt for application for SSI/D, award letter from Harris County Social Services and my Social Security number. I provided every last bit of documentation the Foundation requested.

Now the clincher. It seems they will only endorse checks made out to the rental agent and utility company I use. My rental lease (I have been at the same address over two years) specifically states that the rental agent will not accept second-party checks and will not accept more than one check in payment for the monthly rent. And the light company is hard enough to get along with as it is, and I am afraid that if I were to make a payment under these conditions, they might request that I put down a deposit, which I can't afford. It seems odd that the Foundation has no alternative policy in situations like this. Many people must be losing out who would otherwise be able to use their services.

When I applied at the Foundation, I was told that a case worker would contact me in 10 days. They did not. I finally called them and worked things out to this point. The last person I spoke with was Jean Bennett. We spoke several times and she said she would return my call. She has not.

After spending a lot of time collecting paperwork for all this, I am still no further ahead than when I started. Every other agency I went to was overrun with clients

applying for services. But not AIDS Foundation Houston. I never saw one other client when I was there. I did, however, notice a good-size office in a very nice neighborhood and a car lot full of BMWs, Mercedes and, I believe, even one Lincoln. And the people who work there have a lot of fancy titles like M.S.W. and C.S.W. I guess that's where all the money goes. Oh well....

**AFH Responds**

Dear TWT:

One of AIDS Foundation Houston's primary reasons for existence is to provide services to people living with AIDS, and I am extremely concerned any time one of our 1,400 clients feels he or she has a problem with our performance.

The writer disagrees with the guidelines used to ensure that the limited funds available for rental and utility assistance are utilized for their intended purposes. The requirements listed in the first paragraph of the writer's letter, in most cases, are not dictated by AFH but are requirements set by various funding sources to establish eligibility, residency and, most importantly, need.

In the second paragraph, the writer states his unhappiness with the fact that rental and utility assistance checks must be made payable to the landlord and utility company and not the individual. This policy has been in effect for over 2 1/2 years and is common with most rental assistance programs. I am unaware of any instances in which it has caused an unsolvable problem.

In a perfect world, we would not have to be concerned that people would abuse programs intended for AIDS patients. However, the reality is that this abuse exists. These criteria are to *protect* the writer and everyone else who is living with AIDS and in need of this assistance.

In the next paragraph, the writer states that he was not assigned a case worker within ten days. It is always our goal to accomplish this task within ten days; however, there are some instances when it is not possible. There are no excuses, but several possible reasons for this delay: human error, inability to contact a client or, more likely, the fact that we are dealing with an epidemic. In the last 90 days, AFH has had the largest client increase in its ten-year history. We are currently serving over 1,400 clients, answering over 1,000 calls per month on our hotline and reaching over 80,000 people annually with our AIDS awareness program.

There is no doubt we could use more funding to provide additional case workers, office space (some workers are four to an office) and direct client assistance. Please know that we are seeking these funds everywhere possible, but that available funding is not increasing in direct proportion to the crisis. If not for the thousands of volunteer hours contributed, the problem would be even more acute.

In closing, I would like to mention that AFH shares parking areas with several other businesses, their staff and customers, so I am unsure to which vehicles the writer is referring. However, all staff salaries are in the public record, and I am confident that the writer would be surprised at how modest they are.

I hope the writer will contact me again to ensure that he is getting all of the services to which he is entitled.

### 1992 TEXAS DEMOCRATIC STATE CONVENTION

*Ten Steps Forward,  
One Step Back*

by Robert S. Bridges



This year's State Democratic convention was held June 5-6 in Houston at the George R. Brown Convention Center. The general tone of the convention was fairly tame, since Arkansas Gov. Bill Clinton had sewn up the nomination the previous Tuesday by winning the California primary. Jerry Brown had been rumored to be one of the convention speakers, but was a no-show. The only real candidate-related friction came from the Tsongas orphans, who were working diligently to keep their delegates away from the Clinton deal-makers. However, the overall atmosphere was cooperative, with party leaders and delegates alike starting to look ahead to the November election and the defeat of George Bush.

For gay and lesbian issues, it was a landmark convention for our delegation on many fronts.

#### VISIBILITY

Several hundred delegates signed in at the Lesbian/Gay Democrats of Texas [LGDT] caucus on Friday afternoon prior

to the convention being called to order. It was by far the largest openly gay delegation I've seen at a state convention, and the LGDT meeting was standing room only. It was great to see the convention floor awash with a sea of lavender LGDT buttons. It was also strengthening to have so many rural delegates participating as open gays and lesbians.

#### POWER IN THE PARTY

The most significant gains were made in the cutthroat arena of elected positions in the party. There was a strong gay and lesbian presence on all the convention committees (Resolutions, Platform and Rules). State Rep. Glen Maxey of Austin served as the chair of the Resolutions committee.

If we continue to build on our gains, we can help make gay and lesbian civil rights a matter of course in Texas politics.

Extremely important was the election of Sue Lovell of Houston to the State Democratic Executive Committee [SDEC]. This permanent committee is the highest echelon, responsible for implementing policy and enforcing rules within the party. Sue is the first open lesbian to be elected to the SDEC from Harris County.

#### NEW YORK, HERE WE COME

One of our most dramatic gains was the increase in delegates to the Democratic National Convention, which will be held in New York at Madison Square Garden July 13-16. Instead of the usual paltry three or four delegates, we will be sending ten lesbian/gay delegates to national. The drive for delegate fairness was a unifying element for us this year, and was accomplished by all our people putting the pressure on at every level, from the smokiest back rooms to the rowdiest speeches on the convention floor. It was a hard-fought, satisfying victory.


#### ONE STEP BACK

Unfortunately, our amendment to make the increase in gay/lesbian delegates to the national convention a permanent increase was narrowly defeated in a vote on the full floor of the convention. However, our success at putting together a liberal/

minority coalition on short notice to pull over 40% of the full convention voted raised some big-time eyebrows among the party elite.

### READY FOR PRIME TIME

The most significant factor tying all these events together was the fact that at this convention, the dialogue was all out in the open. Party officials were able to say the words "gay" and "lesbian" from the central podium to 10,000 delegates without fainting or putting their head in a bag. Our committee people were treated with respect at all times, and our coalition partners openly supported us in record strength.

We should be very encouraged by the results of this convention. We've hit a new high mark in the Democratic Party of the New Texas. If we continue to build on our gains, we can help make gay and lesbian civil rights a matter of course, rather than a point of controversy in Texas politics.
