: Space Requirements - Possible Evacuation of Potomac Park Area and Release of 1717 H Street

- 1. This memorandum is for information only.
- 2. It must be anticipated that the scheduled road and tunnel work along Independence Avenue together with the ultimate demolition of the 25X1A6A

 Building and the three temporary buildings in the Potemac Park area will create a serious space problem for the Agency.
 - 3. We are presently assigned approximately ft. of 25X1 epace in the three temperary buildings and the Building. 25X1A6A (Tab A attached)
 - 4. We now have three floors (3rd, 4th and 5th) of the 1717 H

 Street building with a total of approximately

 space. One unit is scheduled to vacate approximately

 of the 5th floor on or about I September. However, we have a request for increased assignment in the building amounting to

 ac after I September our total occupancy will be approximately

 ft. (Tab B) It must be noted that our 1717 H Street units

 are not average office space users and they will be considerably more expensive to relocate than the average office.
 - 5. We must accept the fact that our continued occupancy of the four buildings in the Potemac Park area will become more and more difficult. Also since the Bureau of Public Roads wishes to consolidate their people in the 1717 H Street building by obtaining the space we occupy there, it appears more and more desirable for us to consolidate our functions housed in the above mentioned five buildings into one location which will provide a minimum of the assable sq. ft.

W.
