
Snapshot of American in Europe

American Airlines flies up to 66 daily flights* from 21 European cities* from its U.S. hubs in Charlotte (CLT), Chicago (ORD), Dallas Fort Worth (DFW), Los Angeles (LAX), Miami (MIA), New York (JFK) and Philadelphia (PHL).



03 London Heathrow

American is the third largest airline at London Heathrow, which is the epicenter of the airline's European operation, with up to 20 daily flights.



04 Atlantic Joint Business
