


# How To Transfer On Cotton

This method prevents the iron on transfer paper from slipping whilst ironing, so preventing the lines from bleeding.



**Step 1**

Set Iron to hottest dry setting and press cotton fabric.



**Step 2**

Cut out transfer and place face up on the ironing mat




**Step 3**

Centre fabric on top of transfer and smooth the fabric with your hand so it lies flat as possible.



**Step 4**

Place iron on top of fabric and iron for about a minute. To prevent scorching you can place a piece of parchment paper (baking wrap) on top.



**Step 5**

As you iron you will see the outline being transferred on to the fabric so you will know when the complete outline is transferred.



**Step 6**

The outline showing through the fabric.



**Step 7**

Remove fabric and turn it over. The print will be transferred on to the right side of the fabric.



**Step 8**

Iron print one last time to set. The print is now permanent and ready to stitch.
