

TRIALS TO END TRIBULATIONS

The Jabboury Foundation for Cancer Research is currently enrolling HIV-positive persons with Kaposi's sarcoma to evaluate an anti-tumor and anti-HIV experimental procedure. Participants must be over 18 years of age, seropositive for HIV, with a CD4 of at least 50, with cutaneous Kaposi's sarcoma. All participants will receive the study-related treatment and care at no cost. Jabboury is also looking for persons with AIDS-related ITP for another clinical trial. Participant requirements are the same, yet must also have a clinical diagnosis of ITP and a platelet count below 100,000/uL. Transportation to and from treatments could be arranged. OUTRAGEOUS FORTUNE



ORAL EXAM

In mid-May, the Montrose Clinic began offering OraSure, the breakthrough new oral HIV-1 testing system, as an alternative to the traditional blood test method. The OraSure system does not test saliva, but rather an oral sample called oral mucosal transudate (OMT), which contains high concentrations of antibodies and is free of most of the contaminants found in saliva — key to its high level of accuracy. "HIV testing with OraSure is safe and painless for those being tested and those who administer the test," said Dr. Gordon Crofoot, medical director of Montrose Clinic and well-known HIV specialist. The Montrose Clinic is a nonprofit, community-based agency founded in 1981 to serve people in the Houston area by providing lower cost health, social, and educational services. THE BELL OF THE PRIDE BALL

Gay mover and shaker Deborah Bell has been named the 1997 Grand Marshall for Houston's

Gay & Lesbian Pride Week. Former co-chair of the Pride Week Committee, former co-host of KPFT's *Lesbian and Gay Voices*, Bell rose to nationwide prominence as the national organizer for the 1993 March on Washington. Her involvement provided the infrastructure for future march organizing. DC's then-mayor Sharon Pratt Kelly called the march "one of the best organized she had ever seen in our nation's capitol."

HEAD OF THE CLASS

Professor Eugene M. Harrington has been chosen as Teacher of the Year by TSU's 1997 Class of Thurgood Marshall School of Law. This coveted honor means Prof. Harrington will deliver reflections during the school's Hooding Ceremony on May 16, corresponding with the University's golden anniversary this year. Professor Harrington has also been named 1997 Professor of the Year by the Barbara Jordan Chapter of the Black Law Students Association and the 1997 Distinguished Professor of the Year by Phi Delta Phi Legal Fraternity at Thurgood.

This way, they'll be able to solicit help from other organizations and work in partnership rather than competition."


