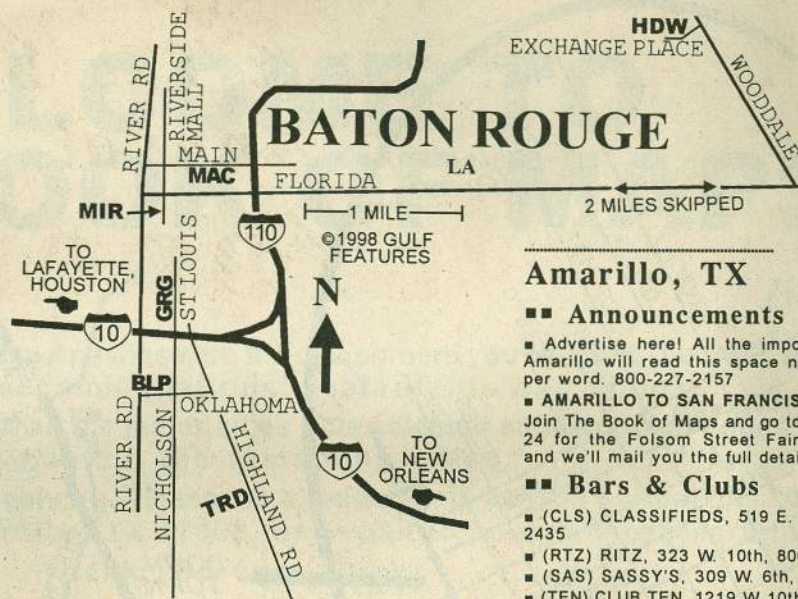
We have a lot of research invested in this reference guide. But please, as a reader, let us know of changes and improvements that you would like in our next issue.

So thanks for picking us up. And be sure and visit the clubs on our maps in your city and as you travel.

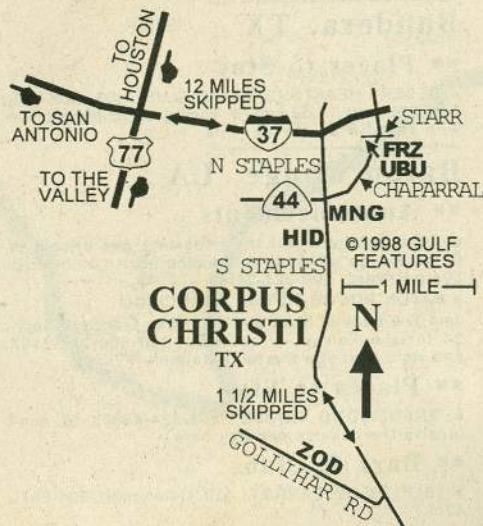
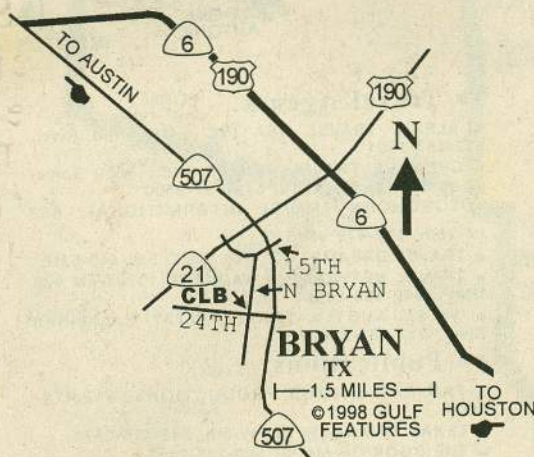
