Houston welcomes participants of 'Let Us Entertain You Weekend'

present its 24th annual "Let Us Entertain You Weekend" with lots of food, cocktails and fun this weekend. Registration is Friday from 8:00 p.m. to midnight at the Venture-N, 2923 Main Street and on Saturday from 10:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. at Mary's Naturally, 1022 Westheimer.

"LUEY Weekend" started as a way of continuing the Mardi Gras party after New Orleans. Originally, as people returned from New Orleans on their way back to the West Coast, they would make a stop in Houston, The local clubs began throwing parties to keep these folks here longer. Eventually, the clubs joined forces and the Houston Council of Clubs (HCC) was formed. The prime function of HCC was as a calendar clearinghouse for local events and to put on the annual "Let Us Entertain You Weekend."

Over the course of these years, LUEY has continued to grow as has HCC. At present the Council consists of nine leather/levi member clubs (Texas Riders, Colt 45's, Sundance Cattle Company, Texas Renegades, Texas Leather & Lace, Lancers, Misfits, Houston Area Bears, and F.I.S.T,); seven "auxiliary" clubs (R.S.I.C.S.S., LVL PWA Holiday Fund, Lone Stars, Rainbow Ranglers,

Over the years, LUEY Weekend festivities have included many bars and restaurants, many of which no longer exist. This year's participating bars include Venture-N, Mary's Naturally, Gentry, Brazos River Bottom and Pacific Street. Other bars and businesses are also inviting LUEY guests to their establishments with events like a private party at Rascals, half-price at Midtowne Spa, or open invitation to Brick's II.

Bob Bouton is this year's chairman of HCC, and has held that office for four years. He has been a member of the Texas Renegades for 12 years, as well as being involved and holding titles in many other clubs and organizations.

Chris Patterson is secretarytreasurer of HCC for the second year. He is a member of the Houston Area

Conference of Clubs.

Last year LUEY Weekend had a record 508 people representing 28 states and three foreign countries (Canada, Germany and England). This year a similar crowd is expected. There will be numerous cocktail parties, Friday evening snacks, three meals on Saturday, and a Sunday brunch. The closing Sunday afternoon LUEY Show will consist of the most outrageous routines seen during the course of the year.

The professional talents of Miss Edee King are being added to this year's agenda. She will be on stage Friday evening at Venture-N and will have a warm-up act on Sunday at Brazos River Bottom. Miss Edee is a singer-comedienne from Atlanta who couldn't resist the lure of Houston's biggest party when she heard about it.

The majority of the cost for the weekend's events is borne by the member clubs through yearly assessments. There is no charge for the entire event for anyone from outside Houston area, and the cost to Houston residents is only \$10.00. It is a great value for very little money.

"The Colt 45's AIDS Trouble Fund (ATF) provides emergency and temporary financial assistance to persons who are suffering from AIDS. We provide payments directly to the service provider, with grants to help with rent, utilities, eye exams and eyeglasses. In the past ten years, ATF has distributed approximately \$323,000 in direct assistance to a client group whose number exceeds 1,100 persons with AIDS."

"The Colt 45's Stone Soup perishable they Program provides foods, namely meat, poultry, vegetables, fruit and other sundries, to of Houston's Stone Soup Pantry on a weekly basis. The Stone Soup Pantry is a food bank for people with AIDS."

"The third fund is the Till Thacker, III General Charity Fund. This fund handles other worthy causes not covered charitable

earlier. Past grant recipients include The Houston Clinical Research Network, Omega House, You'll here about it, you'll see it, the Montrose Counseling Center, and Soiree Aubergine."

The Colt 45's receives the causes from private individuals, providers include, TGRA, Garden Party, just to name a few. The group receives no governmenbe maintained.
