On Saturday night, March 8, The Royal, Sovereign and Imperial Court of the Single Star of Houston Inc. held its annual PR Ball at Days Inn Downtown.

Formerly called Investiture, PR Ball is hosted by the Imperial Prince Royale and Imperial Princess Royale of the immediate past reign.

Each year at PR Ball the new Monarchs name their line of succession and the past Monarchs present their final funds from their reign beneficiary.

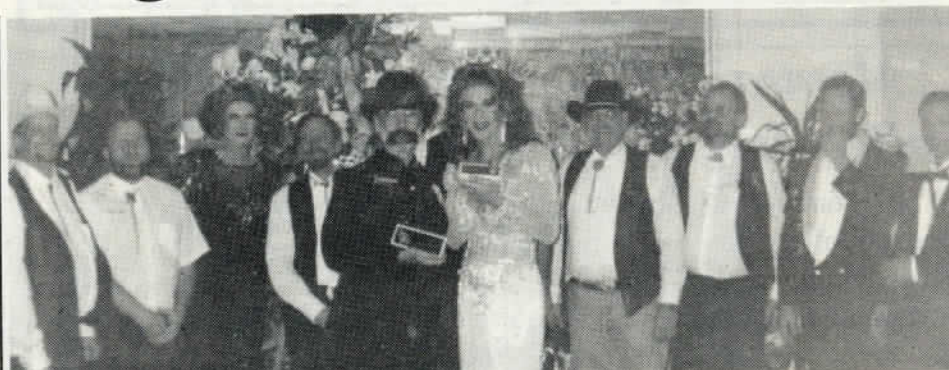
The theme for PR Ball III was "High Stepping into Spring." The Ballroom was beautifully decorated with spring flower arrangements and each table's centerpiece was a high

'Next Step' classes offered to HIV positive patients by Montrose Clinic

Montrose Clinic, a private non-profit organization, offers "Next Step" classes bi-monthly to persons diagnosed with the HIV virus. The classes are anonymous. Class topics will include: health issues, nutrition, safer sex, legal issues and medications.

Clients will also receive an Immune System Panel, which is made up of a CD4 (T-Cell) count, RPR (Syphilis) test, CBC (Complete Blood Count), and a TB skin test. All of these services are **FREE** to the client. Class space is limited, so please contact (713) 520-2000 to make reservations for an up-coming class.
