Montrose Clinic, a private nonprofit organization, offers "Next Step" classes bi-monthly to persons diagnosed with the HIV virus. The classes are anonymous. Class topics will include: health issues, nutrition, safer sex, legal issues and medications.

Clients will also receive an Immune System Panel, which is made up of a CD4 (T-Cell) count, RPR (Syphilis) test, CBC (Complete Blood Count), and a TB skin test. All of these services are FREE to the client. Class space is limited, so please contact (713) 520-2000 to make reservations for an up-coming class.


Texas Bear Round-Up II in Dallas next weekend
