#### Parade Date & Hours

The 2009 Houston Pride Parade will be held on Saturday, June 27, 2009. The parade begins promptly at 8:45pm and runs until 11pm. abOUT Magazine's Official After Party starts after parade at Guava Lamp.

#### **Transportation**

Pride recommends taking Metro to get to and from the Festival, Parade & After Parties. Bus stops are conveniently located along Westheimer for quick access. Please call 713-635-4000 or visit www.ridemetro.org for information on routes, schedules and all of Metro services.

#### Location & Directions

The Pride Houston Parade is located in the Montrose neighborhood running along Westheimer Rd between Dunlavy and Crocker.

Take the Waugh Exit, turning left onto Waugh. Waugh Dr becomes Commonwealth St. Continue on Commonwealth until you reach Westheimer.

From North/Northwest: Interstate 45 South. Take the left lane exit onto Allen Parkway. Take the Waugh Exit, turning left onto Waugh. Waugh Dr becomes Commonwealth St. Continue on Commonwealth until you reach Westheimer.

From South/Southeast: Interstate 45 North. Take the left lane exit onto Allen Parkway. Take the Waugh Exit, turning left onto Waugh. Waugh Dr becomes Commonwealth St. Continue on Commonwealth until you reach Westheimer.

#### Street Closures

**Friends of Pride Bleachers:** Located directly across from the Parade Main Stage, these bleachers are reserved to members of the Friends of Pride Program. Complimentary beverages are provided along with air conditioned restrooms.




