Hope you enjoy Mr. James Franco, our cover boy and as always- Thank you to the community for supporting abOUT Magazine.

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
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
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Remembering a HERO

Rodney T. Castle was known to Houston and across the nation as the founder and CEO of The Osito Foundation. He had moved to Houston several years prior from Arkansas, when he met his life partner Oscar. It was then they took on a journey together, launching what would become one of Houston's most unique foundations. It was also then they fell madly in love and if you knew Rod any bit at all he would tell you this; "Oscar is my world.". Rod was a graduate from University of Ar-

Several years ago around Christmas time, I was invited with The Osito Foundation and their dedicated volunteers to one of their missions at Texas Children's Hospital. You lived, and You loved, You MADE a difference Our Community will never forget that. As Rod would always say: "Big Teddy Bear Hugs"





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


day!" And again I only charge them no more or no less for the drinks. Don't EXPECT free drinks just because it's your freaking birthday.



Tipping:




