RETURN OF THE FOAM PARTY

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Dolly Parton

Well what can I say abOUT Dolly Parton? Only that she is AWESOME! From a super-star country singer to being an actress and all the way to being a successful business woman and philanthropist, who wouldn't think she is the greatest entertainer/do-gooder in the world. Born on January 19, 1946, Dolly Rebecca Parton is the fourth youngest in a family of twelve siblings. With her family being so big, she has always painted a picture of them not being very fortunate when she was being raised.

As history would have us believe, misfortune doesn't last forever. Dolly had always had a passion for singing and being a performer since age nine. She would sing on local television and radio shows in Tennessee which landed her several appearances on The Cas Walker Show. Just as she started to write into the pages of her teenage years, she already was recording songs with a record label named Goldband Records. Just at the age of thirteen, Dolly made an appearance at the Grand Ole Opry in Nashville, Tennessee and this is where she met Johnny Cash who gave her all the words of encouragement and advice that she still sticks to today. Those words of advice were to never care what others thought.

Dolly's first peak at success came from two top ten hits she wrote in 1967 with her uncle Bill Owens and at the same time she wrote a chart hit for Hank Williams, Jr.; All this was just the beginning for her soon to come major success and fame.

Dolly was pegged as to be a bubble-gum pop artist, but that genre never took too kindly to her. She made it to The Porter Wagoner Show and this is where she started recording country duets with Porter Wagoner to which their first single (and every single thereafter for six straight years) went to hit the top ten charts.

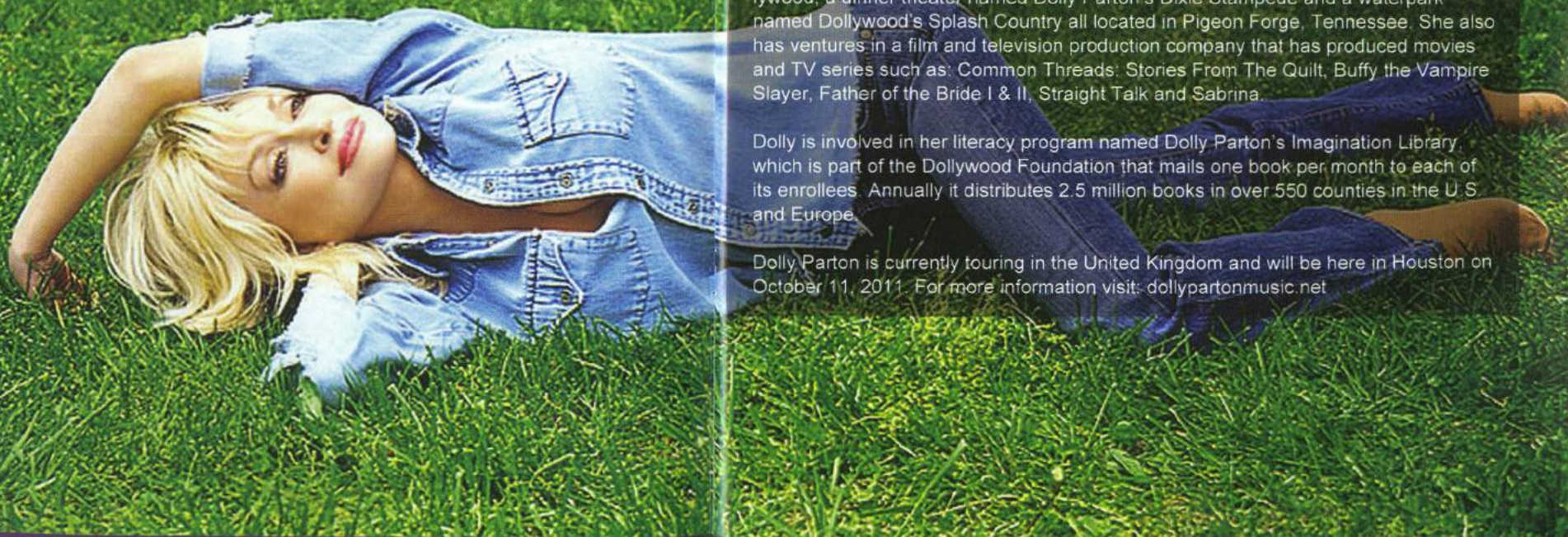
Dolly and Wagoner tried to get her much needed solo success, but to no avail over the next few years. Not until 1970, Dolly hit the big time with her album Jimmie Rogers' Mule Skinner Blues that made it to number three which off the same album her first number one single "Joshua." Her mega hit came in 1973 when she released "Jolene"—it also reached the charts in the U.K. making her an international sensation. Her 1974 hit "I Will Always Love You," was geared towards her professional break-up from Porter Wagoner. In 1978, Dolly won a Grammy for Best Female Country Vocalist for her album Here You Come Again.

Dolly has been on numerous hit movies such as: 9 to 5 (where she had a number one hit 9 to 5 where she won two Grammy's for it), The Best Little Whorehouse In Texas, Rhinestone, Steel Magnolias (drink your juice Shelby), Straight Talk, Frank McKlusk C.I., The Beverly Hillbillies, Miss Congeniality 2: Armed and Dangerous, The Book Lady, Gnomeo & Juliet and Joyful Noise (co-starring with Queen Latifah set to be released in 2012.)

Dolly also owns The Dollywood Company which consists of a theme park named Dollywood, a dinner theater named Dolly Parton's Dixie Stampede and a waterpark named Dollywood's Splash Country all located in Pigeon Forge, Tennessee. She also has ventures in a film and television production company that has produced movies and TV series such as: Common Threads: Stories From The Quilt, Buffy the Vampire Slayer, Father of the Bride I & II, Straight Talk and Sabrina.

Dolly is involved in her literacy program named Dolly Parton's Imagination Library, which is part of the Dollywood Foundation that mails one book per month to each of its enrollees. Annually it distributes 2.5 million books in over 550 counties in the U.S. and Europe.

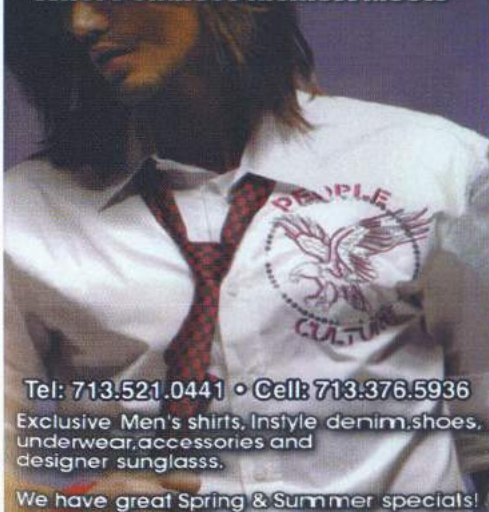

Say what you will about the old Material Girl, good or bad, because that is what has kept Madonna on the forefront of our pop culture for over three decades. So to that, much has already been spoken about what is being billed as her Madgesty's directorial feature film debut W.E. (Her ill received 2008 directed film Filth and Wisdom starring Gogol Bordello's Eugene Hutz is considered a short film clocking in at 81 minutes.)

W.E., co-written by Madonna and her Truth or Dare director Alek Keshishian, tells the story of a lonely New Yorker named Wally Winthrop (Abbie Cornish, who recently starred opposite Bradley Cooper and Robert De Niro in Limitless) who becomes obsessed with the pre-World War II love and lives of King Edward VIII (James D'Arcy) and Wallis Simpson (Andrea Riseborough), a controversial couple in their day, to say the least. Some thought theirs was quite the love story-the King abdicated the British throne to be with the American divorcee Simpson! But, love, as we all know, is never what it seems which Winthrop discovers journeying to England and such; ultimately finding out the truth of Edward and Wallis and most importantly herself. Harvey Weinstein, the man who has produced and distributed many award winning films such as Pulp Fiction, The English Patient and most recently The King's Speech acquired the American distribution rights to Madonna's "labor of love" this past summer. In fact, The Weinstein Company (the studio Harvey co-chairs with his brother Bob) is releasing W.E. in December, a coveted time for Academy Award consideration!

The film does bear some award winning heat behind the scenes: Scott Franklin serves as executive producer who produced Black Swan and The Wrestler, production designer Martin Childs won an Oscar for his work in Shakespeare in Love. Hair and Make-up designer Jenny Shircore won an Oscar for Elizabeth and was nominated for The Young Victoria. Arianne Phillips is once again Madonna's costume designer who was nominated for her work in Walk the Line. Harvey Weinstein said of the December release: "Madonna beautifully interweaves past and present in

W.E. It's a very smart film, and a stunning directorial debut. I'm incredibly excited to give it a prominent release date." W.E. is scheduled to open in limited release December 9 before a wide theatrical release in January 2012.

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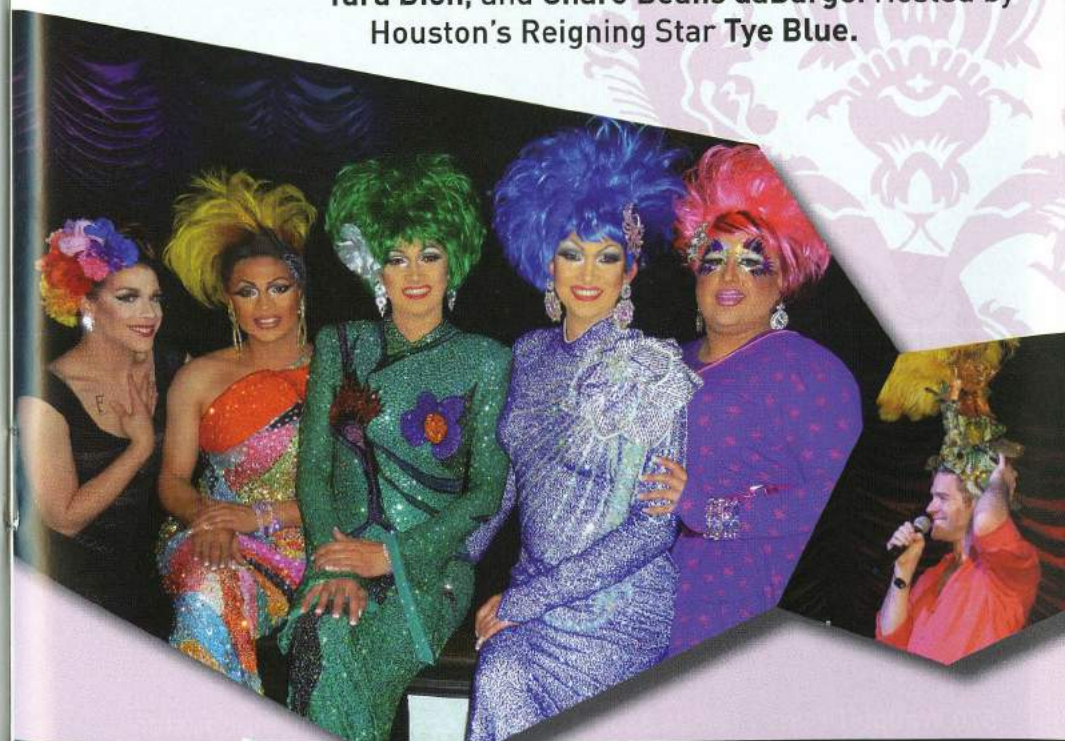

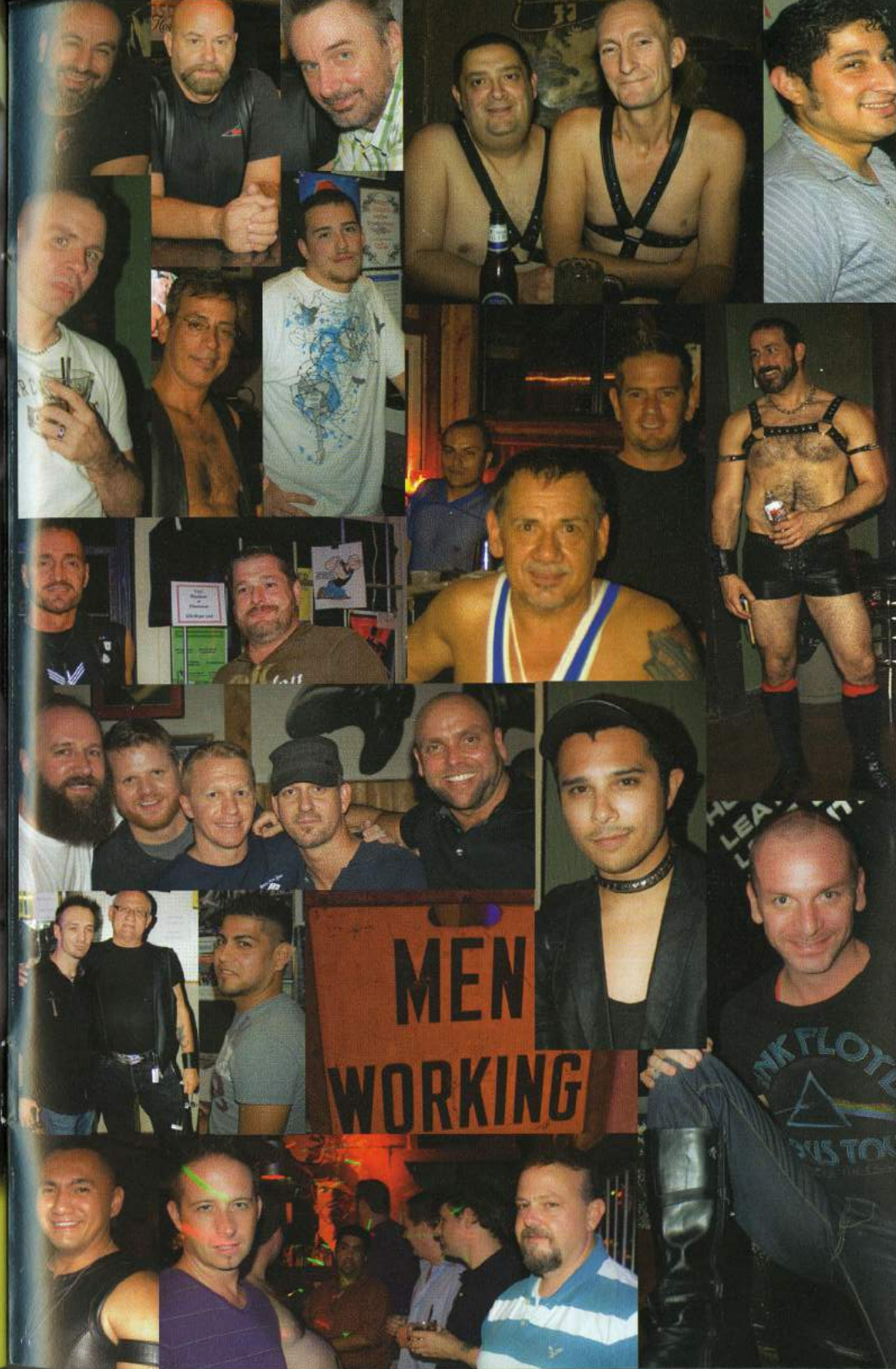
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DJ exceed
