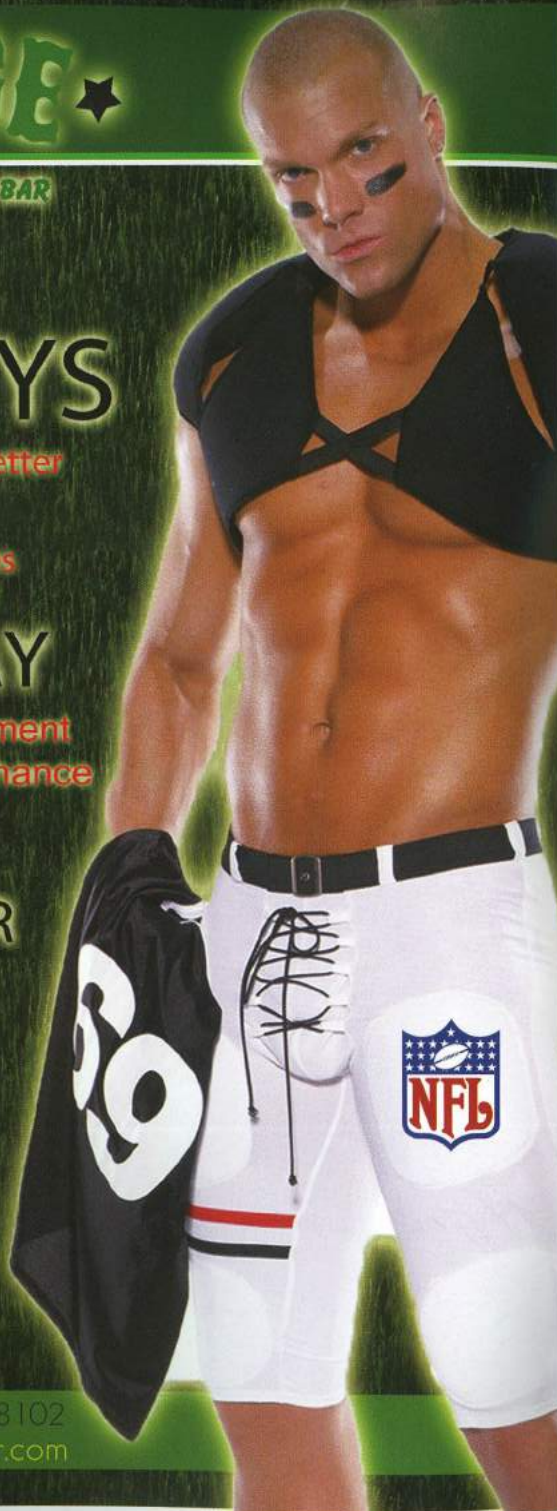

Located in the mini strip center with M2M Style Lounge and Berry Hill. Several signs warn drivers, and the lot is rigged with several cameras. The lot is guarded by Jet Wrecker Services. 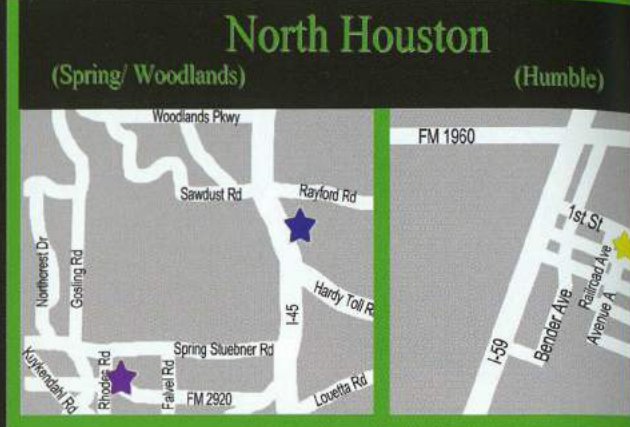

MFAH

When was the last time you admired a great piece of art, up close and in person? Tipping the hot stripper shaking junk in your face doesn't count . . . well, maybe it counts, but I digress . . . I am talking about our own fine arts museum – the Museum of Fine Arts Houston. Where else in Houston can you see everything from 2,000-4,000 year old sculptures and pottery from Italy, China and the Middle East to paintings by such recognizable names as Picasso, Cezanne, Remington and O'Keefe? Not too many places here in Houston that I can think of . . .

The Museum of Fine Arts has amazing collections from all over the world spread across a multitude of locations. It is a complex of sites including two gallery buildings, visitors center, sculpture garden, two art schools, two house museums, library, café, movie theater and gift shops. On top of that, they have rotating exhibits that come in from around the world – from the recent exhibit of Impressionistic masterpieces on loan from the National Gallery of Art in D.C. to an upcoming exhibition of King Tut from Egypt (there's going to be so much gold that Fort Knox is going to be jealous!) In conjunction with all these exhibits,

there are always great talks, lectures, films, workshops and tours to stimulate your mind and your brain. General admission is \$7 (cheaper than a cocktail at the bars). Even better . . . general admission on Thursdays is FREE. . . no turnstile jumping or getting Tazed! The special exhibits are less than \$20 (which is usually cheaper than catching a movie at the local multiplex) and with a membership, you can get discounts on all the special events that go on throughout the year. They have lots of other free events too! And it's just a hop, skip and a drive down Montrose on the other side of 59 to some great culture and an amazing experience. It's not called the Museum District for nothing! It is definitely worth checking out for a little culture in your life! If you want to know more, you can see what I am talking about by going online to www.mfah.org. The MFAH is definitely one of our great treasures here in Houston!

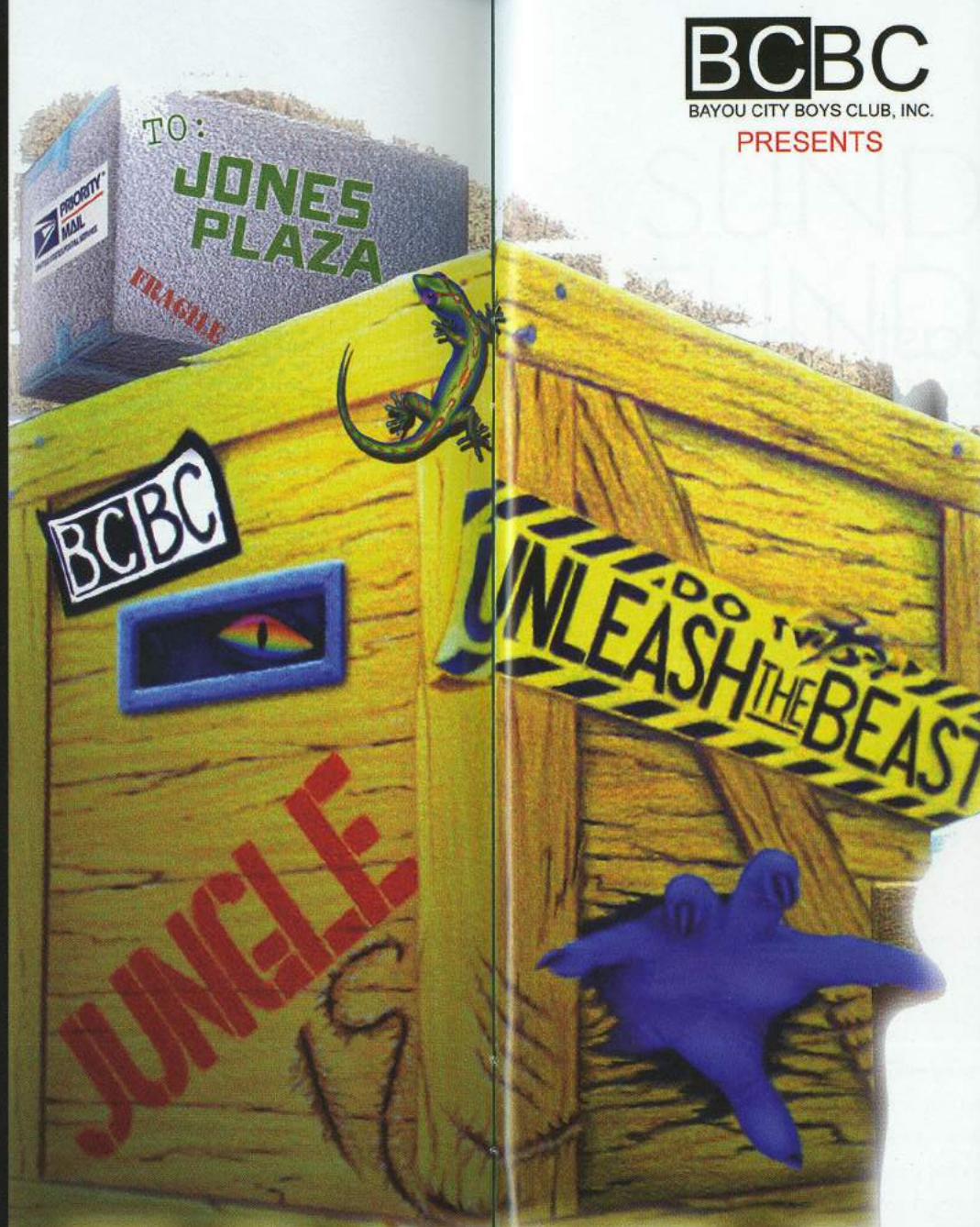

As Gauthreaux sits on a plane to his next destination to enthrall his listeners, he readies for an Exclusive Interview with abOUT Magazine.

When did you know you wanted to become a DJ?
I was always kind of making mixed tapes as a teenager, and have loved dance music ever since I can remember. But it wasn't until I started going out to the clubs and making friends with some of the DJs when I realized, this is what I want to do.

If you weren't a DJ what other profession would you have considered?

I wanted to be a screenwriter for the longest time. When other kids were out playing ball or hanging out with their friends, I'd be locked away in my room just writing stories. I've always been more of the creative type. To this day, I'd still like to write a screenplay or maybe a book. Maybe one day...

I know you have an extensive list of places you travel to, but when do find time for Joe Gauthreaux?

All the time. But honestly, this job is my life and I like it like that. Whenever I'm not traveling, I'm at home in my studio working on new music, shopping for new music, or doing something on the administrative side of my job. It's fun for me. But I have a lot of close friends that I spend time with. I'm really big on going to the movies, or taking hikes at Runyan Canyon.

What is it like playing for other countries say like China?

I love playing in other countries because they're just so energetic and happy to have a guest DJ there. They're not allowed to be as open with their sexuality as we are here in America now, so they just release so much pent up energy in the clubs. It's very exciting. I'm also very fascinated by the fact that no matter where I go, music is a big unifying factor. Language barriers become irrelevant because music pulls everyone together. It's pretty awesome.

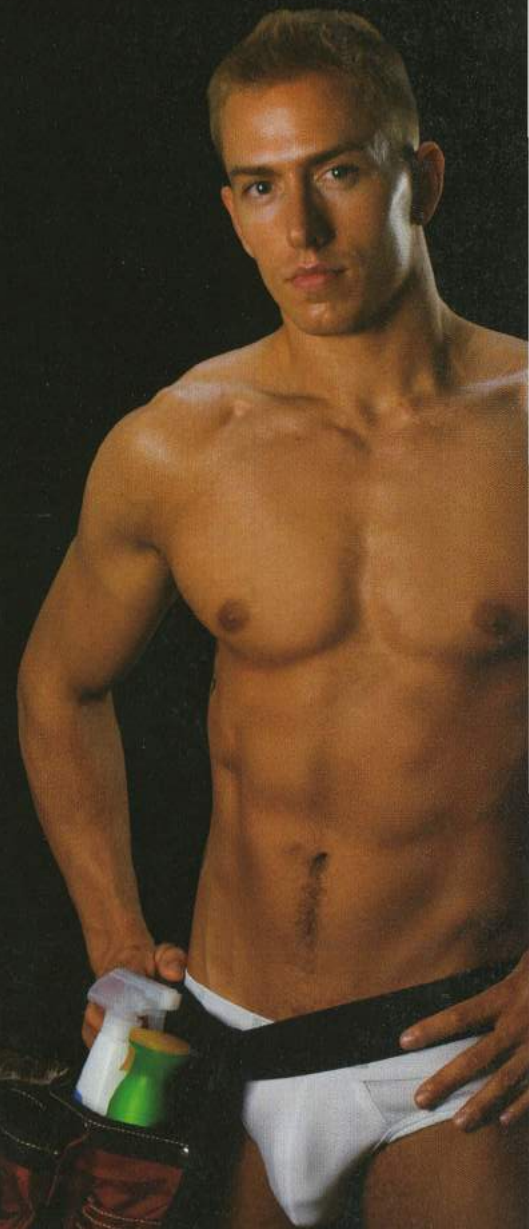

A LITTLE HEALTH FOR THE MIND

A friend once asked me: what do we need to have a healthy relationship? Since I am not an expert in the subject, I decided to ask one of my psychiatry colleagues for advice. This is what I came up after talking to her. Regardless of gender, our partner is a human being with whom we have the opportunity for personal growth and we should grow in our relationships. There are characteristics that we need to work that can lead us to healthy relationships.

1. Keep the personal appeal: This is not to seek the appearance of super-models or culturally created stereotypes. It is the fact of caring for the body to improve the image, feel good about ourselves, considering what your partner likes and loves about us.

2. Identity what do I bring to the relationship: Almost always we look to our partners and we know what he brings to the relationship (or what he doesn't), but we are rarely aware of what we contribute to the relationship, perhaps the quality and quantity time, willingness, patience, understanding, listening, etc.

3. Assertive Communication: This point is crucial: guessing how much love my partner feels toward me or vice versa, is a common mistake. How to express? Preferably assertively, speaking from my emotions and my being, for example, saying "I am angry," or "that upsets me" instead of "you make me mad," or "you make me upset or angry."

It is very important to express how much you love him. Do not communicate only when you have problems.

4. Respect: How difficult is it knowing that the person with whom we share our lives (either long or short) can have an opinion with which I disagree and respect him. We deserve respect in our ideas, thoughts and actions. He deserves that too.

5. Activities in common: How important is to keep a space for the couple, built only for members of the relationship only. Sometimes with work, school, and for some, the presence of children, time seems to be absorbed in space; gone! Trying to bring it back is a challenge. For this reason, prospectively take some time of the day and devote it (metaphorically speaking) with love and

caring, for you and your partner, including here the erotic aspect!

6. Update agreements: tailored to the needs of each member of the couple. It is important to review the arrangements for the couple; work on issues that are considered to be relevant (economics, sexuality, living together, friends, family, loyalty, etc.) Make a deal and keep to it. As we change with time, the agreements should be updated to our needs, as persons and as a couple. We are the ones that decide what is acceptable for our relationship and what it is not. But this should be a mutual pact.

7. Expectations: We forget that each person is different, and that the possibility of providing "something" in the relationship is different in every human being. Each of us has our own personality, our history, values and the ability to "meet" healthy expectations. We might just not know if we meet his. This is why it is so important to communicate.

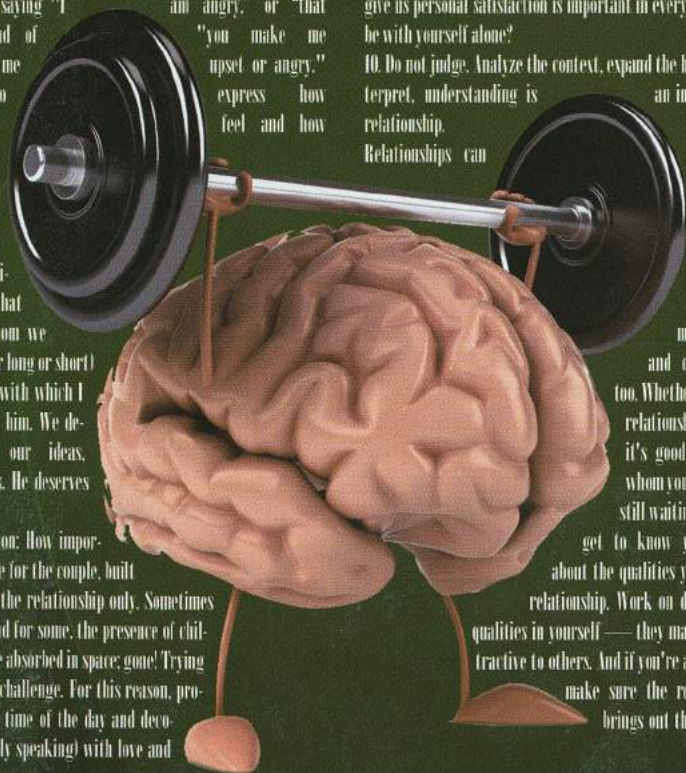
8. Strengthen personal health: You can't love if you're not happy with yourself. If we do other activities, for example, professionally, we will feel happier with ourselves and bring happiness into the relationship.

9. We are different individuals: The idea of the other half is different, because that would be reduced to half in search of an identity. Knowing that we are full human beings, with rights to private spaces, moments to give us personal satisfaction is important in every relationship. Can you be with yourself alone?

10. Do not judge. Analyze the context, expand the horizon of what we interpret, understanding is an ingredient for a better relationship.

Relationships can be one of the best — and most challenging — aspects of our life. They can be full of fun, romance, excitement, intense feelings, and occasional heartache.

too. Whether you're single or in a relationship, remember that it's good to be choosy about whom you get close to. If you're still waiting, take your time and get to know yourself first. Think about the qualities you value in a healthy relationship. Work on developing those good qualities in yourself — they make you a lot more attractive to others. And if you're already part of a pair, make sure the relationship you're in brings out the best in both of you.
