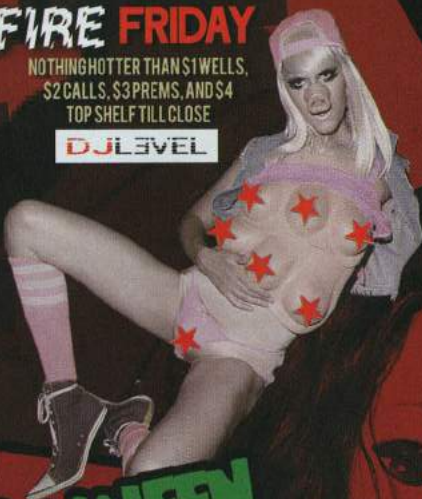

Yes, I'm a good catch. (Laughs)

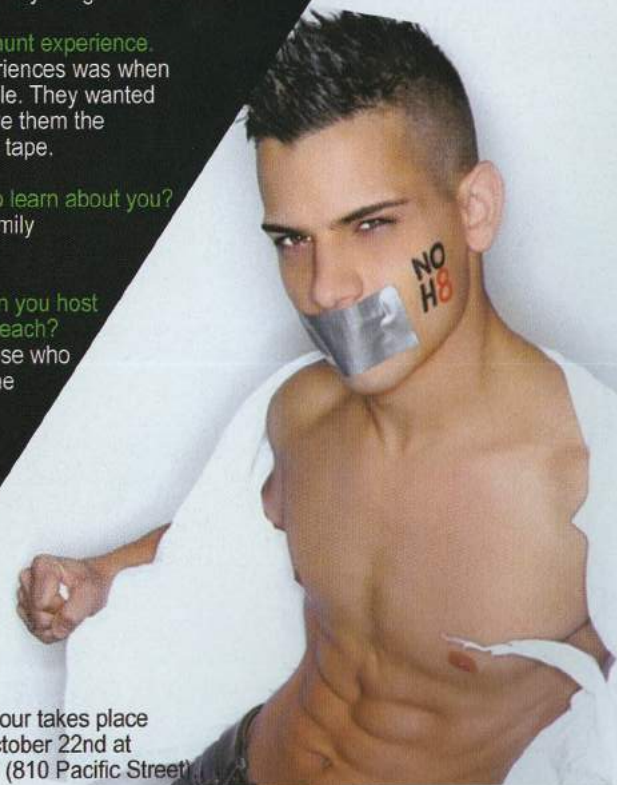
Besides a body of steel, what do you offer?

The Rocky Horror Show, hmmmm, what can I say about this musical? Eccentric, bizarre, weird, whimsical and odd are just a few words to describe the whole slew of exoticness this musical exudes. From its transvestite dark character to the virgin-esque couple that is caught in a web of out-of-this world proportions; this musical carries a strangeness that no one is prepared for. The musical is a long running parody of B-movies from the 1940's through the 1970's. It was first premiered in London in June of 1973 and is written by Richard O'Brien.

The story starts off with a young couple named Janet Weiss and Brad Majors whom get engaged to each other at a friends' wedding. Afterwards, they incur a flat tire on a dark, wet, windy road. This is where their adventure into the unknown begins as they find a nearby castle to ask to use a phone. The owner of the massive dwelling is Dr. Frank-N-Furter, a transvestite from Transsexual, Transylvania. They become engulfed in a web of illusions produced by Dr. Frank-N-Furter in which they become trapped and essentially enslaved. show, the film, was released in 1975 and still is shown in movie theaters across the nation (mainly shown for midnight showings.) If you've ever had a chance to grace the presence of attending a viewing you know that you are in for a real treat. People wear costumes, bring interactive items to participate in the movie (i.e., rice for the wedding, water-guns to simulate rain, party hats to pretend you are at the birthday party on screen, etc.), bring their singing voices and best of all loud mouthed comments.

The film has taken in over \$140,000,000 since its debut. It is the first movie from a major Hollywood studio to be in the midnight movie market and is the most internationally recognizable and successful midnight films of all time. The United States Film Registry accepted The Rocky Horror Picture Show as being "culturally, historically, or aesthetically significant" in 2005.

In parallel, Twyford teaches at the University of Houston's G.D. Hines College of Architecture.

Twyford is a co-founder/producer of the growing in popularity "Haters Make Us Famous," in which he attends to every other Thursday at Boondocks bar/club. The music that is mixed and outputted is eclectic and jubilantly processed through your ears to the mind; thus creating an atmospheric bliss of synergy between the music, DJ(s) and the crowd that eagerly wants more. I've had the pleasure of attending many of these Thursday night "adventures" as I call them because you can be taken on a fantastic voyage of 80's, 90's, electronic and whatever they damn well please to serve. The experience is kept fresh by giving way to a themed party every performance. 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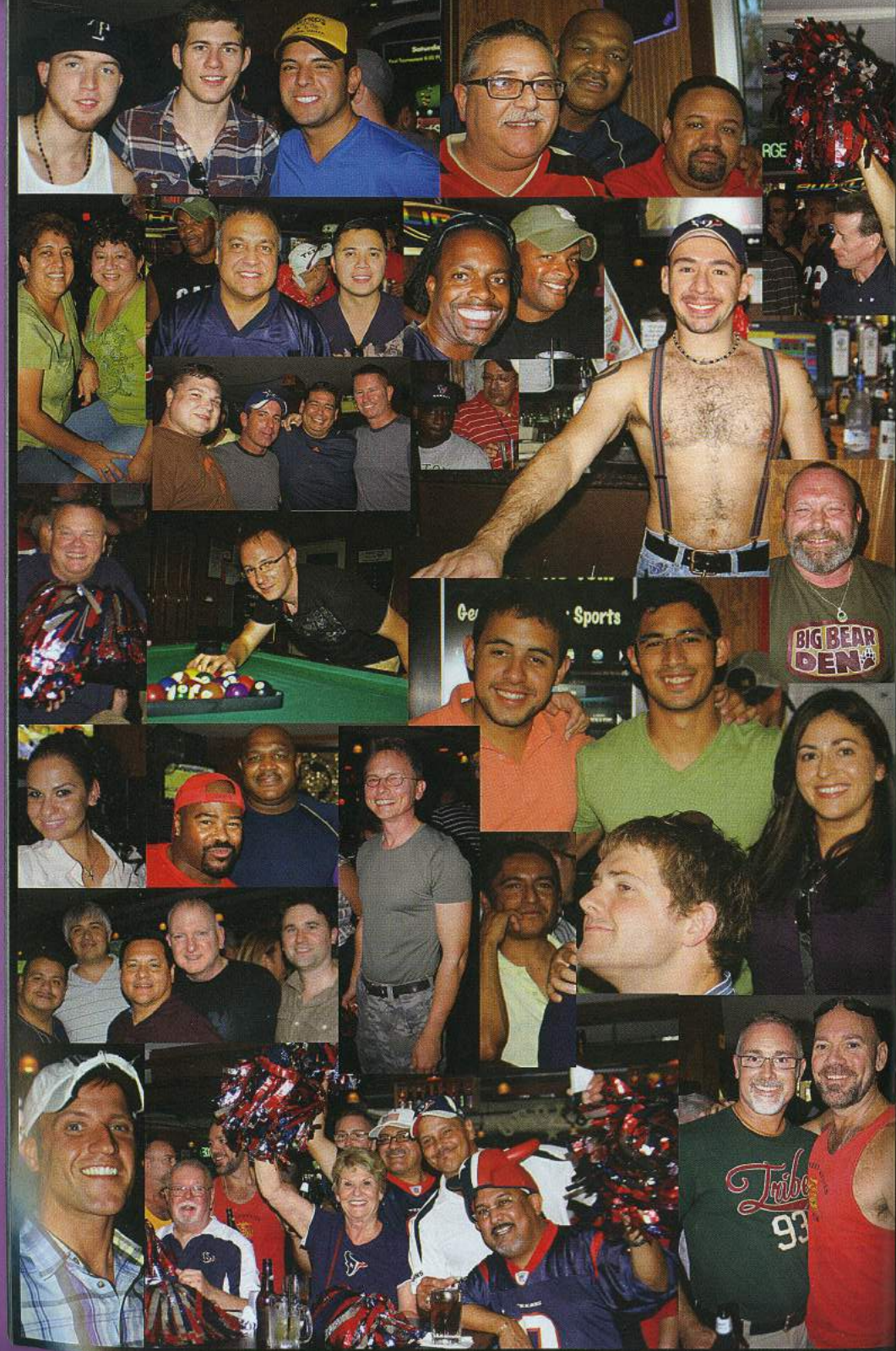
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
