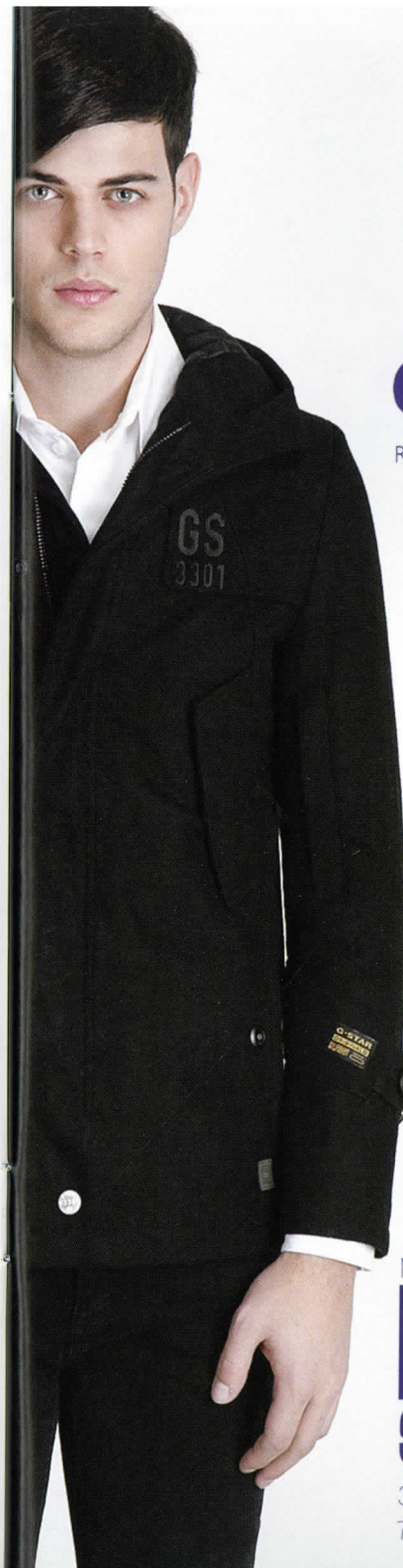
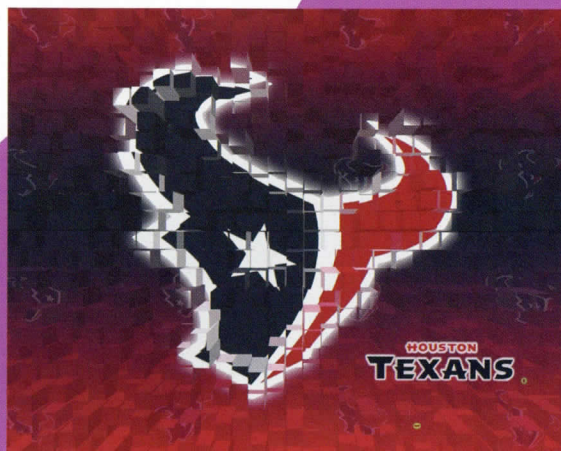
HOUSTON TENNIS CLUB

The HOUTEX 31 Tennis Tournament will take place at the Houston Tennis Club (HTC) between November 11 and November 13, 2011. The HTC is a non-profit organization and was founded in 1980 to engage and endorse tennis players alike.

They stand by with their stance of not discriminating or denying membership on the basis of race, gender, sexual orientation, religion or creed. The HOUTEX tournament is one of the oldest and most prestigious gay tennis tournaments in the United States and is sanctioned by the Gay and Lesbian Tennis Association (GLTA), a member organization of the United States Tennis Association (USTA). Texans running back Arian Foster was named the AFC Offensive Player of the Week following his performance at Tennessee on Oct. 23. It is the third time Foster has won the award in his three-year career and the second time this season he has garnered the honor.

Foster became the fourth player since the 1970 merger to score three touchdowns and have more than 100 yards rushing and 100 yards receiving in a single game in the 41-7 win against the Titans. The 2010 NFL rushing champion carried the ball 25 times for 115 yards and scored two touchdowns on the ground and had five receptions for 119 yards, including a career-long 78-yard touchdown grab in the second quarter. Foster is the first player in Texans history and 32nd player in NFL history to have more than 100 yards rushing and receiving in a single game.

It felt like the first time I kissed a girl. It was hella weird. After a horrifying 8th grade year, we moved again to Harrisonville, Missouri, and I was taken back by the first boy I had a crush on... Brandon, and man, what a love story. Drowned by the social pressure of and culture shock from the transition from Alaska, I had finally begun to find myself again, until my parents found out about myself as well. I was forced to end my first relationship at a cool six months by being kept locked up, only being allowed to go to school, show choir practice, and work. That ended after I turned 17, where I made the biggest decision of my life to embark on Life.

I had moved around Missouri chasing happiness, with only a motorcycle and my heart. I started by landing a job at Starbucks to pay the rent. After two years of barely making it in a slow city, I had decided to upgrade, so I transferred to a store in Dallas, TX last January. I began school almost immediately, and had decided to major in vocal performance. Almost two years down the road to this day, I'm now a bartender at BJ's NXS in Dallas, TX, and a traveling automotive spokes-model.

Q: How did you hear about BJ's, and what made you want to bartend here? How long have you been there?

A: I discovered BJ's in a rather unorthodox way. I had met a guy at the Starbucks I was working at, and he asked what I was doing that night. I had no plans, so what could I do? I had never been out and about in the city, so off I went. He ended up having me meet an older man at BJ's for drinks, like many boys do. "Hell, who doesn't like to get free drinks," I was thinking. I loved the bright lights. I drafted so much attention I had around when I needed a change of pace. I walked in and landed a job as a bartender, and the rest is history.

Q: What should a customer know when approaching you, and what's your favourite drink/shot?

A: I've learned as much about drinks as I have about people at this bar. I always approach people with a smile and a hug, and when I'm helping one person, they're just as important as family. I love my job. I've met too many amazing individuals. Customers should also know that the best way to get my number is to simply be interesting and independent... And single! Too much time at the bar gets in the way of my business, and customers who chase me for a night are automatically out. There has to be a healthy balance of visitation and awesome conversation to win me over. I'm there to make you have the most badass night you've had, and I love customers who make my night a badass one as well.

Q: Have you ever modeled?

A: Yes. I have worked with Hans Farhmeyer, who has done previous shoots with 2xist, and whom has photographed high-profile celebrities. I'm currently looking for solid representation to expand my commercial, film, print, and acting opportunities as well.

Q: What's your fave candy?

A: It depends on how I feel. I almost consider Oreos to be candy, because just how the owl licks the Tootsie pop just to get to the center, all I care about is the cream filling... Hahaha. Wow.

Q: Have you ever been to Houston?

A: I actually have! When I lived in Kansas City, I was dating a med-school student at KU Med. It was late at night on a Wednesday when we decided to drive to Chicago, but somehow, hours later we were exiting into Montrose. We tried to go to this one club but it was closed, so we just headed to the 24 hour Starbucks by the Galleria. I didn't get a chance to experience the city, but would love to find a club to guest bartend at.

Q: What is something you think that all of our readers should know?

A: .I'll tell you, as my best friend says, "It's always the smallest person on the totem pole that will boom you. Treat everybody with top of the line service, because those are the people that will get you where you want to be."
