Believe it or not this was the first interview abOUT Magazine has done in a bed! Sitting with Tye in his cozy Montrose apartment, while he has root beer and cold left over pizza. This is one of the nights this entertainer has off and he is feeling the homebody realness. In between the interview The glances at Logo TV.

The LGBT Houston community knows him as one of the rising stars in our community. Hosting events and power dealing charity fundraisers. Tonight Tye Blue opens up for the first time about what all comes with being Houston's most powerful event host and producer, Born in Richmond, TX, raised all over Ft Bend unty and growing up on the south west side of Houton, The graduated from tiny Needville High School in 1998. "I had been studying private saxophone at U of H from '96 - '98. I was offered a full ride to U of H but opted to go to the very expensive Berklee College of Music in Boston instead." After a short time in Boston he decided to drop the sax and focus on theatre, which brought him back to Houston and finished up college at Sam Houston State in Huntsville studying Musical Theatre and Directing.

From there his entertainment career moved nothing but a fast pace. "I started doing unpaid theatrical shows in Houston around 1999 and worked at various local theatre's like Main Street Theatre. TheatreLab, The Little Room Downstairs; I think my first official paid "gig" was singing and dancing in the big Showcase Theatre at Six Flags Astroworld. Polyester body suits for days." By 2003 he had done at least one show at almost every theatre in town - all the while doing tons of random odd jobs to stay afloat. Then The got antsy and moved to Los Angeles.

Being the center of attention was not always on his mind. The still feels the need to express he never wanted the spot light. "I know most people won't believe this but I've never really pined for the spotlight like I'm in it now. I've always just wanted to sing or perform or direct. It's one thing to play a part and be known as an actor, because you can hide in that, but it's ENTIRELY different to be well-known just for who you are." Shifting from hosting events to being dead center of the spotlight just happened he explains. "I just think a lot of people recognize me and know my name...for me that's all it is."

The dedication to events caught the eye of F Bar Houston's owner Irwin Palchick and with the opening of the club, The was quickly hired to handled all special events for the bar, and since that time has created and hosted events like F Factor with Emmy winner Ernie Manouse, hosted almost all of the Ru Pauls contestants, and even American Idols."The hosting element is easy to step into, as I did speech and debate throughout high school; I'm not afraid of just being in front of people speaking impromptu. The challenge is to be funny. I'm still working on that but I rely on the quick-witted drag queens to help in that department." Tye adds.

On the heels of Tye Blue's "Testify" at Vue Nightclub on July 15th. "TESTIFY! is something that just came to me one day. I am not a religious person; we never went to church as kids. But I've found that I needed spirituality to get me through the emotional demands. I absolutely find life and strength in gospel music, and wanted to create a brunch/show where those who might also feel disenfranchised from a religious experience could come and worship and party." The first event held in mid June of this year was nothing less than a success. "TESTIFY! was a huge undertaking and stepping out of my comfort zone at F Bar. Fortunately I'm not someone who is a control freak. I realize that a good leader has to be able to seek out good help then delineate responsibilities accordingly and step back. But I feel as long as you are clear-minded about the direction of the event and aren't afraid to let people help you to the best of their own ability, then the collaboration is sure to birth something magical. I'm ALL abOUT creative collaboration.

Beyond his commitment to the Montrose community; devotion to non-profit sector, Tye launched his own non-profit, the Mellow-Blue Arts Initiative, and by this fall will begin giving scholarships to young underprivileged arts students in the Houston Area. Tye holds loyal with Legacy Community Health Services. "They went out of their way to help me with my medical needs when I first arrived back in Houston with no insurance."

After success like this you have to ask whats the next five years hold? "In terms of career, hopefully I'll be hosting my own television show and doing high profile singing and acting appearances here and there. I'd love to be bi-coastal. Perhaps I could host a TV show that's produced here....who knows."
