# LARRY by Cade Michals AS"Hot Chocolate"

I'm sitting in Las Vegas with Larry Edwards, one of Sin City's most known entertainers, as he wears silk shorts and tank top looking very relaxed and full of life. Larry Edwards is an entertainer's entertainer. People in Houston might know Larry as "Hot Chocolate" or one of the "Fab Four," that included Naomi Sims. Tasha Kohl and Donna Day, a piece of drag history that will never be forgotten.

Born and raised in Ft. Myers, Florida, Larry knew from a young age he was gay. Being his only son, Larry's father did not accept this, but after a few years, he came to terms with it. "My mother really enjoyed the drag persona Hot Chocolate and accepted me being gay from the beginning. My younger sister also happens to be gay as well" Larry says. Discovering drag at a young age, Larry was fascinated by other entertainers and the crowd's reaction, which allowed him to express himself more openly on stage.

"It has taken many years of perfecting the illusion of Tina Turner. I would constantly watch her videos, television appearances and her concerts. Performing six nights a week in "Divas", as well as others, it gave me the extra practice to work on my Tina Turner tribute." Larry is one of the most well-known Tina Turner impersonators in the world, with movie credits that include; "What's Love Got to do With it" and "Miss Congeniality 2" as well as stage shows; Fabulous Four, LaCage, and currently Frank Marino's Divas Las Vegas.




"I've worked with Frank Marino for many years at LaCage and now Divas. I'm very proud to

One of Vegas' living legends Frank Marino is sitting across from me wearing almost nothing. It's Friday in Las Vegas and it's his day off.

Our first question that was asked of Frank was how his show was doing, he responded with "the shows have been amazing! It's summertime in Vegas, so it is always packed!" What is great about this show in particular is they accommodate for all age brackets, so they don't have a set "busy season". This is one of the leading contributors to the show's success and longevity.

"When I got to Vegas, which feels like a hundred years ago, it was more formal. I call it the end of the Mafia Era, which I really liked. People would come in dressed, men in their suits and woman in their formal gowns, a very glamorous time. Nowadays people are more casual. It's defiantly not the glam that it use to be" said Marino.

Frank came to Vegas 25 years ago to star in a show called "LaCage", but once his contract was up, he decided it was time for his own show. He gathered his resources and the most talented friends from all over and created the "Divas" show, the same show that is still running at the Imperial Palace now.

"I change clothes on stage an average of seventeen times per show and I was just placed in the Genius Book of World Records. I have done over 20,000 shows and that comes to over 360,000 costume changes".

We offer Frank Marino a huge round of applause, because as of July 21st, it will mark his 1,000th show with "Divas". We praise you for your boldness as well as your humility.
