I'm sitting in the MIX 96.5 studio with Blake Hayes. He looks completely at home rocked back in his chair sipping on his iced coffee and eating what appears to be Thai. With no surprise, he is sporting his signature t-shirt and cutoff shorts look with a little bit of clay on his shoes from a charity kickball game earlier in the day.

Growing up in Connecticut, Blake will be the first to let you know that he "wasn't living some Martha Stewart lifestyle or something!" He's proud of coming from a modest household with his mom being an artist and his dad a construction worker, and he feels that it has made him appreciate everything a lot more. His education credit goes to Emerson College, in Boston which Hayes describes as, "a very artsy school with a huge gay and gay-supportive population."

As a young child, Blake has always known that his calling was to be in radio. At the age of twelve, he hooked

up a couple of discman players, a karaoke microphone and a tape recorder and did the "Blake Radio Show" with his best friend Tommy. "Yes, I have the tapes to prove it, no, you can't hear them" he told me. I was sensing it wasn't the best quality, but come on, you know it would have been a good laugh for both of us.

Before coming to Houston this past January, Blake worked in New York City doing a mix of part-time and freelance radio and TV jobs. Once he started looking for something full-time, with a mix of luck and perfect timing, a job was offered to him at MIX 96.5.

"I'm so glad I was lucky enough to get the job and move here. Houston is home, and I am surprised to say, honestly, I love it here"

My personal favorite quote from the interview was when I asked him some of his political views. "I try to keep tabs on what's going on, especially when it comes to issues of equality. get so frustrated when I see how galvanized our opposition is, and how hateful they can be. For most of us, we've found a way to make being gay just a part of our daily lives; we have to remember that under the law, we're still not equal and just because I'M not being discriminated against, there are a lot of others out there who live in small towns, without supportive communities around them. They deserve much more effort from the folks, like me, who have the opportunity to stand up and speak out", states Blake.

As the new F Bar Tuesday Drag Live host, we can't wait to see what he will bring to the celebrated show. "There are some big shoes to fill with Tye's departure because he really built both of these nights into what they are" he told me. All of that aside, I know Blake will have just as much support from the community that everyone before him has had.

"My job is to keep the show going, keep the energy up and make sure everyone, from the customers to the performers, is having a good time!" - Blake Hayes

This is only the beginning of Houston's love for Blake and I'm sure there are many great things we will come to see from him in the future.
