The hallways and shelves are filled with photos that span four decades of Sally's life. That seems about right, just a normal woman, proud of her family and accomplishments.

In more recent news, and one that hits very close to home. Sally has become one of our strongest advocates for equality. Sally Field delivered a heartwarming speech on behalf of her openly gay son when accepting the Human Rights Campaign Ally for Equality Award, in Washington D.C. this past month. She spoke on behalf of all the mothers, fathers, brothers and sisters that don't have quite the platform that she does. She made it known to the world, that she loves her son and wants his rights to be the same as everyone else's

Sally has never openly talked about her son Sam's sexuality before, and made it very clear that it is his business to speak of. She quotes, "There are so many children who struggle to understand and embrace their sexuality in families who do not welcome them, with parents that somehow find it acceptable to shut them out their hearts and their homes, and that I find unacceptable."

Probably the highlight of the night was one of her final remarks of her speech in which she addressed the HRC crowd and said, "You've changed and are changing the lives of little boys and girls who realize somewhere along the way they're just different from their other brothers and sisters. and so the f**k what?" PREACH! Sally Field, we love and praise you for your courage to help us in this time of need. I only wish there were more like you in aiding us in our struggle for equality. But one thing is for sure, with you on our side, we are on the right track!.
