Come one, come all! It's time to party! With only a little over two months to go, the "high priest of gay parties", Jeffrey Sanker, is ready for another fabulous White Party. This year, they will celebrate its twenty-fourth birthday and probably one of the biggest gay events this country has! Even after so many parties, they continue to deliver year after year. Known as a "fly in" or "circuit" event, this year is sure to prove as no disappointment.

When asked about why he chose Palm Springs over anywhere else, Sanker replied, "it is only two hours from LA, and in April, people are not going to the beaches yet. The desert is just beautiful out there. I also wanted to get people outside the clubs in LA, and get them out in the open. It's so gay friendly out there". The concept came from Sanker visiting a few big parties. He states, "I wanted to create one for boys! I wanted to create a camp, a weekend getaway camp for boys".

The last question we asked Jeffrey Sanker really showed us what kind of man he is. One who truly believes in his product and will stop at nothing to deliver. We asked him what if you woke up tomorrow, and everything with White Party was gone. What would you do? His reply: "I'd start over, one small party at a time, 300 people. I believe in what I do. I'd figure out a way to make it happen. I'd do it again!" Our hats are off to a true visionary in the party industry.
