"It's a sexy series all single people can relate to," he says of the show that is based on Heather Rutman's popular book and blog of the same name. It follows three friends, Sam (Rebecca Blumhagen), Jenna (Meg Barrick), and Megan (Tessa Harnetiaux) and the rules they use to have fun and avoid being hurt in relationships. Rules like "Be a Super Tease" and "Relationships are great when you don't give a shit".

"Dating, trying to figure out the right game to play or not play, trying to have fun, keeping from getting our hearts broken... it's things we single dudes do everyday," he continues.

Joe plays Tyler, the friendly bartender on the show. In the first season, Tyler spent most of his scenes behind the bar. But this year he has come out from behind the bar, figuratively and literally. Yep, dreamy Tyler has found love - with a man.

Now if only Joe Komara could, too ...

So, you're a gymnast?

I am! I actually tried diving first but I wasn't comfortable being so wet all the time. It turned out to be a good thing. Gymnastics set me up to be the man I am today. I owe my pretty decent biceps to my early years in the gym. And the tumbling prepared me for my dancing which helped my musical theatre career.

Was the goal always to use the stage as a springboard onto screen?

Actually, no. I started in the business wanting to be a singer. I didn't think screen acting was a realistic goal for me.

How did you make the leap from stage to screen?

It wasn't quite a leap, more like a doubledutch hop. My first television role was on As The World Tums.

How did you land your part on Cinemax's The Girl's Guide to Depravity?

I met with the producers, director, and casting people all at once. Lights, cameras, and audio were all set up. They gave me the green light, I did my thing and apparently, they liked me. A few weeks later, I got the offer.

How has the industry changed for out actors? You know, not that much. The people running Hollywood are still telling actors to not come out or act too gay. Everyone has this liberal view of Hollywood, and as a community, Hollywood is liberal but the business of making movies still has to appeal to the ticket and cable-buying public across America. And, as someone who has traveled to the majority of the states in this fantastic country, I'm going to say it: with a few exceptions, most of America still isn't ready to accept out actors.

What does your character, Tyler, add to the show? Tyler was created as a sounding board for the girls. He's there to hear how the girls followed the rules and if they worked or not. The writers' eased Tyler's sexuality into the show, first labeling him "an equal opportunity whore". I had a crazy over-the-top sex scene with a woman in the first season. That was fun.

Would you date Tyler?

I think Tyler is a decent and funny guy who tells it like it is. I can appreciate that so yeah, I guess I'd do him.

Do you follow "The Rules" when dating? You know, there are some I do follow. Like "settling is for quitters". I refuse to settle.

What is the rule to get attention from a guy? There are a number of them. You can "be a super tease" or out-drink your competition by being "the last man standing". We should all remember the best rule, "It's not how you get his attention, its how you keep it."

What's next for Joey Komara?

More of the same. I've been choreographing, dancing, writing, meditating, doing some film projects, auditioning, keeping up my pompadour, working on the 'craft'... all that keeps me pretty busy. And, of course, I've been concocting some hair-brained rules of my own and testing them through trial and error... mostly error.



- AbOUT Magazine got the opportunity to sit down with Braly in an intimate Q&A. Nothing was off
- Q: First off, what was the deciding factor that led you to come out to your fans & the world back in April?
- A: Well, I never wanted my sexuality to define who I am. So in the past, I kept it quiet. Trying to balance the truth with being an entertainer in the country music industry was exhausting. After I attended a Human Rights Campaign Gala this year, I decided it was time. I discovered that I was not helping myself nor was I helping others like me who are struggling with their own sexuality. I struggled to find the courage to stand proud of who I am & my hope was that my courage would be infectious to others that were in the same boat.
- Q: How do you feel the public has reacted to you since?
- A: With love. The overwhelming support has been amazing. Kind of makes me wish I had done this years ago.
- Q: So is that what you're doing with your new single, Live Laugh & Love; telling your story?
- A: Yes. I set out with a goal to tell my story through this song but it really has developed into a story that many can relate to. That's why I felt it was so important to have a full story-board music video this go around. I knew that a video would really bring the story full circle. Plus, my actual partner got to play the part of my 'partner' in the video so that was exciting.
- Q: Can you share with us what the song is about for you?
- A: For so long, I have hidden behind who I really was as a man and always put my music career first. I not only kept myself in the closet, but I kept my past & current partner in the closet so that they would not blow my cover so to speak. In the midst of doing that, I forgot what it was really like to live your life...and I mean really live your life. I forgot what it was like to laugh out of pure happiness and most importantly, I had never really learned how to love because I wasn't giving it my 100%. That's where this song comes from.

- Q: The story you're telling about yourself is a brave move on your part, do you consider yourself a fearless person?
- A: No, I'm not always fearless. I'm usually a little bit afraid to try new things, but I try to not ever let that take over. I think when there is a sense of fear, it motivates me. Usually I just tell myself, "Screw it, you can do this." And then that's it, my mind is made up and I do it, and if it was 100 percent a success, that's great, and if not, that's okay too because I still did it. But I am a perfectionist, so I'm always re-evaluating and so I can make whatever it was better the next time. Also, I'm a little bit of an adrenaline junkie so fear can be fun.
- Q: I know that you have been a huge advocate for bullying & child abuse prevention in the past. Is that still something you're passionate about?
- A: Absolutely! The statistics surrounding child abuse as well as bullying and the negative impact it has not only on their lives but society is horrifying. These poor kids need as many people as possible out there standing up for them and rooting for them. They need to know that someone's got their back. We all can do our part to make a difference.

Braly's new single will be releasedand marked by a live performance at Neon Boots Dancehall & Saloon, November 22nd at 9:30 pm.
