Rocking the DJ spotlight this edition is a VERY well-known name in the dance music world – someone who has stood the test of time and still reigns supreme, the one and only DJ/Producer Tracy Young! When you take a look at remixes that are hot in the scene today, you'll see a number of mixes by Tracy. Whether you're standing in the club listening to the music, dancing on the dancefloor or reading a Billboard magazine, her name is prevalent. She's an amazing diva that is driving the fun back to the dancefloor!

She's got over 20 years of DJing and production work behind her; she has literally played everywhere—from major club venues to exclusive private events, like Madonna's wedding. She remixed hot artists like Britney Spears, Kelly Clarkson, Akon, Madonna and dance music from the underground to the mainstream, going from clubland to mainstream celebrity. She scored a gig as a hip-hop radio DJ in the 90s and was able to successfully parlay that into being queen of the circuit today. "I love all kinds of music," the Washington, D.C. born spinstress states. "Growing up in a divorced household, I always took comfort in it."

When Tracy first started, there was no money in it for her and she wasn't out to get paid - it was purely a hobby, which lead to an obsessive passion. "I was shocked when I started getting paid" she says with a grin. At the time, she had no idea of the heights to which she could rise. "If you told me 10 years later I'd be DJing at Madonna's wedding, I'd say you were crazy!" she laughs.

sound and the thriving Gay circuit scene were a perfect match – and the boys loved her! They were drawn to her by her magnetic musical pull. Celebrities from Cher to Sean Combs fell under that spell, inviting her to spin their exclusive private parties to A-List invitees.

Once Madonna coronet-ed her as her go-to DJ in 2000, Tracy went from being a solid circuit party player to a global electronic music celebrity in demand at nightclubs around the world! Plus, with her production skills, she's become a name on the Billboard charts racking up 40 #1 Club Play hits including 13 Madonna remixes and as well as imaginative electronic reinventions of songs by Christina Aguilera, Shakira, and Enrique Iglesias. Hot!

more, plus, she's coming to Houston on Easter Sunday (4/20)! So here's a quick recap on the Gay community's favorite DJ: Tracy's DJ career began in 1989, whether she knew it or not! "I was fascinated with nightclubs and used to frequent a local hot spot in DC called TRACKS!" Tracy says, "I then bought the equipment, which at that time were two Technics 1200's and a mixer. I began practicing for hours at a time. It was more of a hobby because at the time not many women were accepted playing live at nightclubs. I basically had to teach myself how to DJ."

It was a tough road for Tracy as not too many female DJs, even today, are considered power players in the scene, but just try to stop her - "when somebody tells me I CANT do something. The word NO makes me have to do it!" she says. What she has been able to accomplish over the last two decades most folks can't do in a lifetime! She's taken her irresistible passion for Even from her earliest stages, Tracy's musical prowess made people take notice, and it wasn't long before she translated her hobby to a thriving career - which allowed her to bring her funk, hip-hop and old-school blend of beats to the masses on eastern corridor airwaves and cable television.

For every DJ looking to grow their career, Miami, NYC or L.A. beckons. She chose Miami and with that move came a shift in sound that she discovered was a perfect fit for Tracy. She was able to inject her hip-hop roots with the house music thump that emanated from the celebrity-filled nightclubs that comprised the Southern Florida scene.

Miami became not only a proving ground for Tracy, but also the arena where she came to discover and hone herself to what she is today. She discovered that her Your standard housewife's life isn't for Tracy— it never has been. With a book in the works about her 20 year-career in the DJ booth, a Mad Men-style makeover by famed Hollywood photographer to the stars Mike Ruiz and longstanding working relationships with Macy Gray, Maya, and the Kardashians, Tracy is becoming a full–fledged celebrity in her own right. "I will always be a music person," she says. "But there are so many mediums for me to express myself, and I want to take advantage of them all."

Tracy Young will headline the "A Trip Down The Rabbit Hole" party by the Dirty Disco Boys Easter Sunday (4/20). It's located at the underground club Kryptonite (709-Franklin, downtown).
