In swimsuits or birthday suits, the guys in this hottie calendar are raising money for HIV charities and we can all get behind that.



"We really wanted to do something that brought a focus back to HIV/AIDS which still impacts gay and bi men in huge numbers but keep it fun and sexy," says calendar producer, FCKH8.com's Mike Kon. "The gay and straight models on the shoot had a great time shooting it with only a few cute awkward moments between them that made us all laugh. The behind the scenes video captures it all. These guys are really worked out and we're glad to be able to show that off to benefit the work that HIV/AIDS charities are doing."

Photographer Justin Monroe added, "We think that with these sexy photos we might be raising a bit more than just awareness and funds when some quy see it."
