





something up. I do think the accent of the location is a good support to the shoot."

Sometimes though, the location presents itself without warning. An image from the book shows a huge, multipart metal object of some kind suspended behind and contrasting with the flesh and bones of the shirtless man in the foreground walking down the middle of railroad tracks. Hard versus soft; inanimate versus animate. The powerful image is the result of a railroad bridge happening to be up. Vino saw it while passing by with a model. "I stopped the car and said, 'Let's go.' I got lucky and shot for 45 minutes."

Layers and a textured look are important to Vino. "There is pleasure in seeing a naked body," he says. "It can stand alone. But I can also say, 'Wow, he has a great body, but under what circumstances does it become more interesting?"

From the book, an example of how Vino takes a great body and makes it an artistic image is the photograph of a man laying solo on a rumpled white-sheeted bed. Dark lines cross his body, fanning out like stripes on a candy cane. But are they really stripes or are they shadows from some sort of grating? Did the sun just happen to come through the window at that angle? Were the dark lines placed purposely to accent the raw sensuality of the man? The viewer has to decide.

Vino says his own sexuality affects his work, which is often males in intimate poses. "Any good artist has his own vision, his own erotic vision, whether a photographer, a painter or a writer. Sexuality does affect the imaging, the creating of a scene."


Helping with this creative effort is Vino's partner of 19 years. "Craig is on 75 percent of the shoots," Vino says. "He is very much involved with the styling of the shot and does a lot of model casting. We work and play and live together. We got together right out of high school."

The type of models the two look for are men without attitude. Gay or straight? Vino says it doesn't matter and the book has both. But he does add that he finds gay men are often easier to work with when he's doing erotic poses.


"I am self-taught," he says. "Did a lot of reading. A lot of photography has to do with experience and mistakes you make. You learn times of day, types of skin, types of film. You either have the eye or you don't. Nobody pays anyone to press a shutter. It is all about practice and staying on the edge."

fun, so show up with your best material girl garb, or your best **SEAN PENN** drag, and get ready to enjoy some "Music" (pun intended).


