

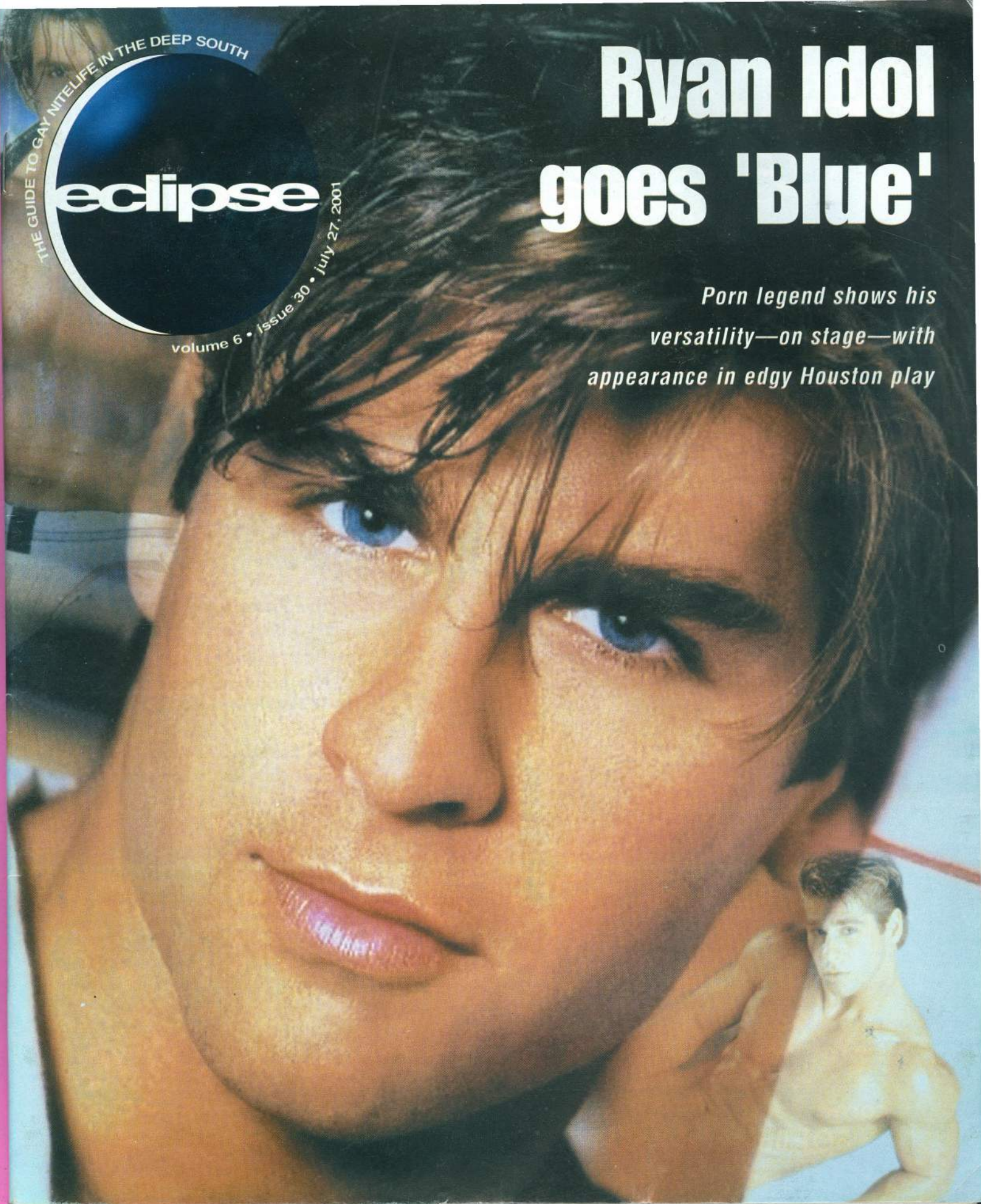

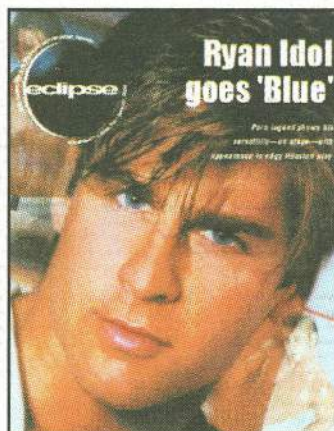

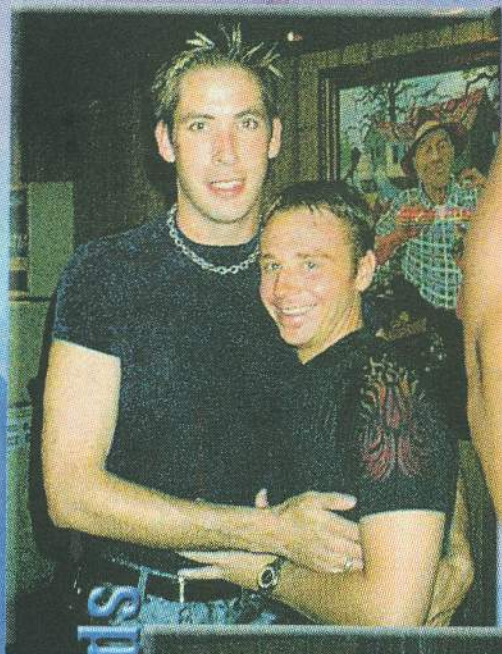

IDOL THOUGHTS

on stage

**porn superstar hits houston
stage in racy production**

HOUSTON—Gregg Rodriguez probably had no idea the rumble he'd create across the United States the day he submitted his script, "Blue Boys," for consideration at Ashland Street Theatre's "New Playwrights Series." After all, it was a fictional play, loosely based on rumors and innuendoes he had heard about the rise and tragic fall of a famous porn star. But Vaughn Dampier, Ashland's owner, saw the potential behind the great story.

After a few re-writes, and some good fortune when it came to casting, "Blue Boys" made an impact well before its opening this week. Landing porn legend Ryan Idol as the lead certainly helped.

Although a stranger to Houston's stage, Idol is far from a novice actor. "Blue Boys" will be Idol's fourth production, following successful runs of "Scent of Rain," "10 Naked Men" and Idol's first foray into stage acting, "Making Porn." Thanks to that experience firmly tucked under his belt, Idol attacks the role of porn star Joey Stefano with confidence and excitement.

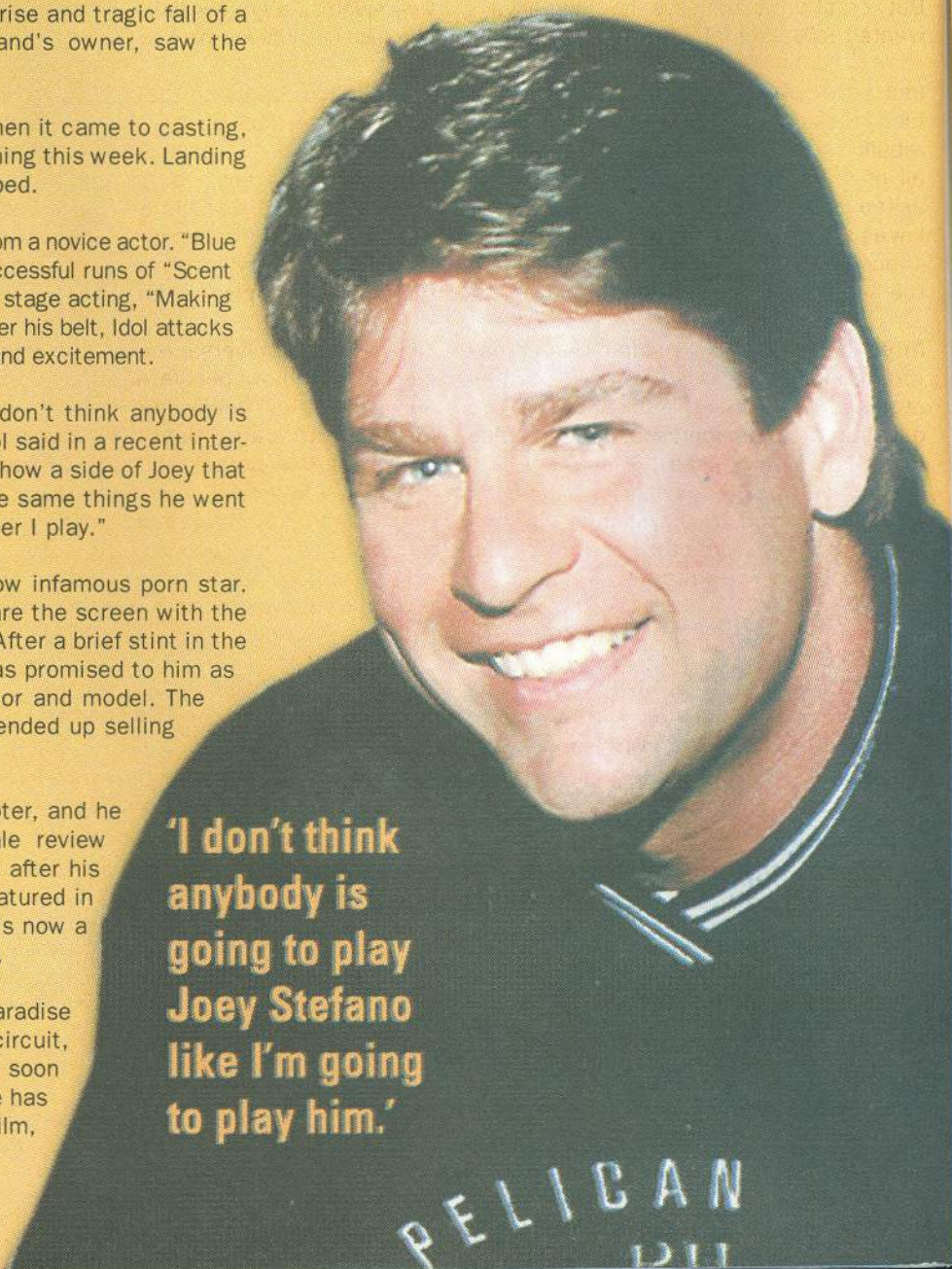
"Joey has been portrayed in other plays, but I don't think anybody is going to play him like I'm going to play him," Idol said in a recent interview held in the Houston theater. "I'm going to show a side of Joey that hasn't yet been seen. I went through a lot of the same things he went through, and that comes through in the character I play."

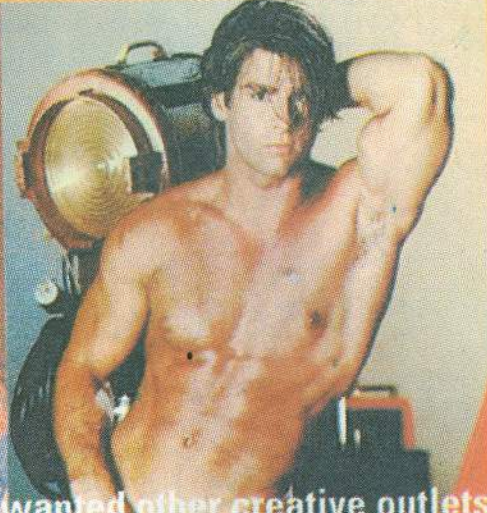
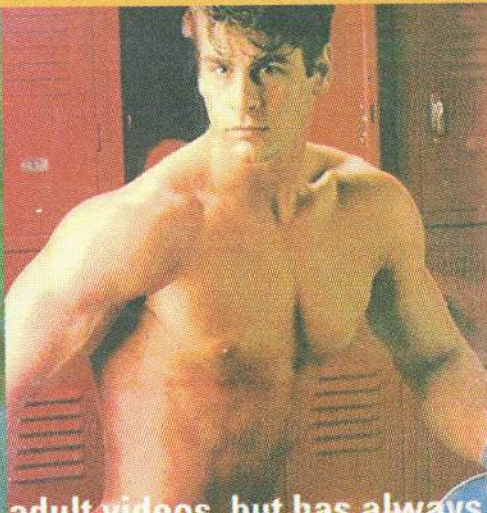
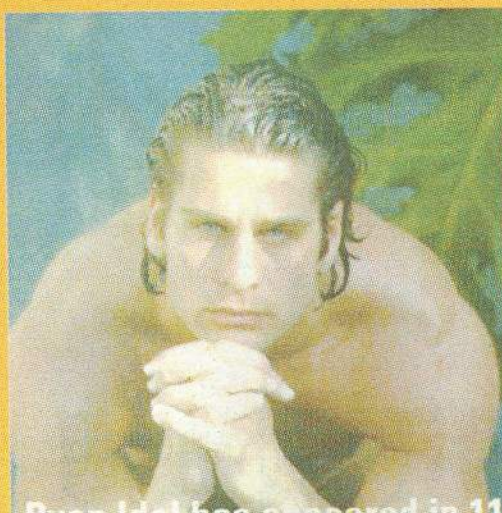
The stage seems a natural transition for the now infamous porn star. From early childhood, Idol says he itched to share the screen with the role models he grew up watching on television. After a brief stint in the Navy, Idol ended up in Hawaii, pursuing what was promised to him as a once-in-a-lifetime chance at becoming an actor and model. The star-in-the-making says he was scammed, and ended up selling hand-made jewelry to tourists.

"At that point, I was eyed by a nightclub promoter, and he approached me about appearing in an all-male review called 'Paradise Playboys,'" Idol recalls. Shortly after his arrival in the nightclub circuit, the actor was featured in a *Playgirl* centerfold in 1989, the start of what is now a well-known life in the adult entertainment world.

Idol returned to the mainland when the "Paradise Playboys" stint ended and worked the strip circuit, going from bar to bar and living on tips. He was soon approached by an adult video producer and since has been in 11 films, six gay movies, one straight film,

and four that feature solo performances. But creatively, he says he has always wanted to do something more.

Idol says a near-death experience about four years changed his outlook. "I had to rebuild the structure I was internally, gain all of my self-worth back," Idol says. "I asked God to send me a sign as to what I was supposed to do with this second chance at life. The next day I was offered the script for 'Making Porn.'"

After that successful run in cities across the country, Idol veered away from theater and again sought guidance. "Three days later, I was approached about 'Blue Boys,'" Idol says. And the spiritual connection Idol takes into the Houston production is one shared with the cast, director, producer and the writer.

"On choosing Ryan, it was meant to happen," says Dampier, who also plays the role

of Chi Chi in the production. "I thought it was very spiritual, a great way to show honor for Joey and his untimely demise."

Brett Cullum takes on the directing helm of this production. His resume includes at least 10 shows, ranging from George Bernard Shaw pieces to the dark comedy of Nikki Silver. Given his extensive background in stage, Cullum gives the story a sense of depth and gravity not common to the "underwear play" genre.

"It is about a universal theme, the struggle between how people are seen to be and who they really are. The whole metaphor to carry this point home is based upon a porn star," Cullum says. "The outside world views porn stars as these highly sexual creatures that live in this world of physical perfection; egocentric individuals that have sex and drugs available to them at every turn. Basically, everything gay men fantasize about."

That's not the reality, he adds. "These people are frail, fragile human beings. The play delves into several characters involved in this world, and how eventually the outer mask slips for each one of them. Ryan is perfect for the part, in his real life he was very different from his roles on film. He brings to the table some acting chops that none of the other porn stars can lay claim to. Given what has gone on in his personal life, I knew he had the emotional baggage to pull off Joey Stefano. They both have a parallel track," Cullum says.

Idol and Stefano appeared together in "Idol Eyes," one of Stefano's first films.

"We were both new to the business, and we became buddies on the set," Idol says. "We got to know each other well many years later, and developed a friendship. We were a lot alike. He had a good soul, but his soul was lost."

But gay porn fans might be wondering how an on-film top like Idol can portray a voracious bottom like Stefano appears in his films. "It isn't about Joey being a bottom, and me being a top," Idol says. "The play is about our life experiences and how they paralleled each other. That (inconsistency) seems to be what everybody is talking about. I hope that's not the only aspect people are interested in."

Backers of the Houston production also dismiss the physical differences between Idol and Stefano. "Idol is taller, physically broader, and older than Joey was during the time frame of this play," Cullum says. "That is not irrelevant to people who are expecting a Joey impersonation. But, this production is not Joey's life story."

And the production doesn't fall short in the skin department, either, Idol says. "We have enough skin to satisfy the sinners, and enough plot to satisfy the saints," Cullum says.

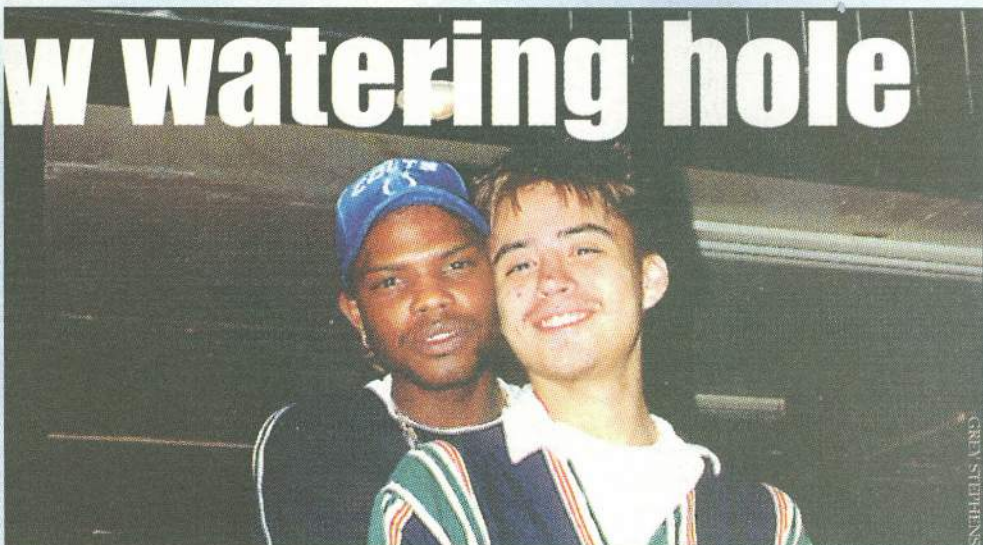
NEW PONDEROSA, 5007 South Flores, a laid-back and casual neighborhood bar south of downtown, is always open to newbies, even you.

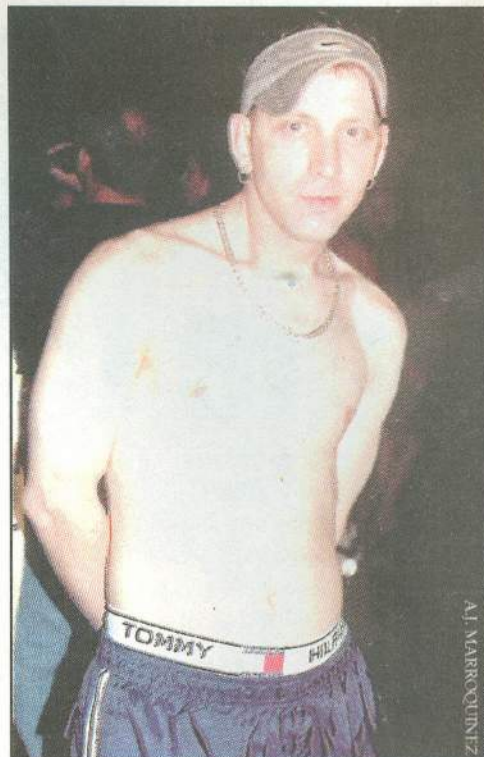
beach party bingo!

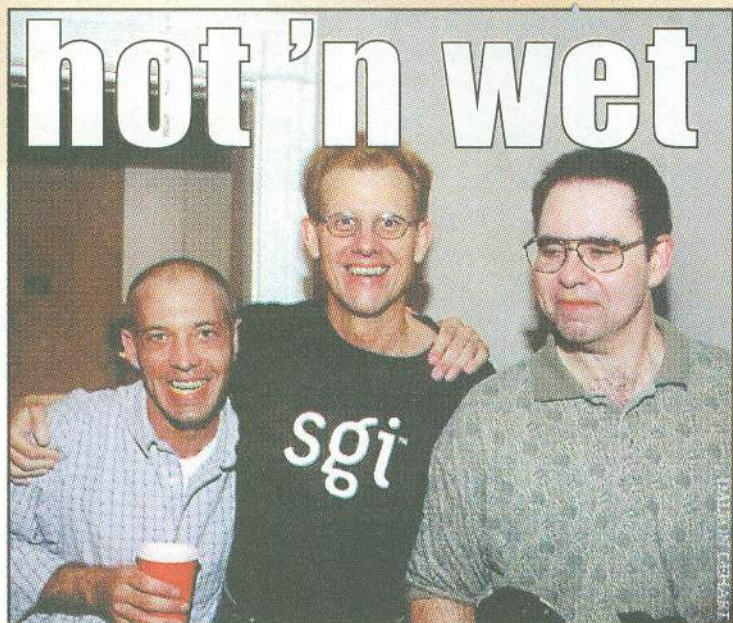
time to get hot 'n wet
