

Citybus Launches Five Special Routes Connecting the Kai Tak Sports Park With Plans to Introduce Airport and Boundary Services

(27 February, Hong Kong) The opening ceremony of Kai Tak Sports Park this Saturday (1 March) marks the start of “Hong Kong Super March”, a month filled with excitement. Citybus is fully prepared and is pleased to announce the launch of five special routes on this significant day, connecting citizens and tourists from the Park to Kowloon, Hong Kong and the New Territories, offering the most convenient and direct transportation services. As a key player in promoting Hong Kong as the “Events Capital” of the World, Citybus is in discussions with the authorities to introduce a special franchised bus route from the Park to the airport and boundary control point during future mega events. Additionally, we aim to add regular bus stops at the doorstep of the Park on our daily services, enhancing foot traffic and revitalising the area.

After enjoying the captivating opening ceremony of Kai Tak Sports Park this Saturday (1 March), audiences can hop on five special routes operated by Citybus, which are the most direct and quickest connections to the heart of Kowloon, Tseung Kwan O, Tuen Mun, Central and Western District, and Eastern District. These routes will also offer direct access to key Citybus interchange hubs at Tuen Mun Road, Tseung Kwan O Tunnel, and the Hong Kong Island, ensuring a seamless interchange experience to everywhere while enjoying discounted fares. “Concert tourism” and “Mega Event tourism” will be significant driving forces in boosting the tourism industry and the wider economy. We have been in close discussions with relevant departments to provide fit-for-purpose transportation services for the tourists attending events at the Kai Tak Sports Park. We plan to launch dedicated franchised bus services from the Park directly to the airport and the Hong Kong-Zhuhai-Macao Bridge Hong Kong Port. Tourists will enjoy direct access to their destinations, enhancing their travel experience and providing a seamless, one-stop experience during their stay in Hong Kong.

Currently, several of our daily bus routes pass through the Kai Tak Sports Park, including the Cityflyer A25 which connects the airport and Hong Kong-Zhuhai-Macao Bridge Hong Kong Port, Route 608 which offers quick cross-harbour service and Route 22M which connects railway stations. To further facilitate access for citizens and tourists to the Park and its surrounding commercial and sports facilities, Citybus is exploring options to add bus stops along Shing Kai Road and Shing Fung Road. This will make it easier for customers to hop on and off our buses inside the Park area. By providing regular dedicated bus services to the Park, we believe this could stimulate retail and tourism development, realizing the concept of “tourism is everywhere.”
