2. Inclosure 1 is the report of survey provided to this command by Letterkenny Army Depot (LEAD), the activity responsible for the loss of the test sample. Actions have been taken by the LEAD activity to prevent future losses by controlling the MX-7338/PDR-27() Radioactive Test Sample and its end article application, the AN/PDR-27() Radiac Set, by property book assignment. In addition, procedures for disposal of commodities containing radioactive material have been reviewed and reemphasized with the individuals responsible.
