

#### LAHAINALUNA HIGH SCHOOL BOARDING PROGRAM

#### Application for the 2025-2026 School Year

Established in 1836, the Lahainaluna High School Boarding Program is for young men and women in grades 9-12 who wish to gain an education as well as life experiences at Lahainaluna, but do not live in the nearby vicinity of Lahaina. The Boarding Program best serves students who are highly independent, reliable, responsible, and motivated. Boarders live a life on campus that reflects the rich culture, tradition, and pride of its program while taking advantage of the academic, social-emotional, and extra-curricular opportunities.

#### **OBJECTIVES OF THE BOARDING PROGRAM**

- 1. Promote student achievement by creating desirable work habits, wellness, self-sufficiency, self-discipline and an understanding and acceptance of responsibility in each boarder.
- Create an environment that will expand each boarder's life experience academically, vocationally, socially and culturally.
- 3. Build leadership and resiliency skills.

**APPLICATIONS** are due on or before April 11, 2025. Applications are available at Lahainaluna High School and various public intermediate and high schools in Hawaii. Parents and applicants are to complete the application together. Forms are included in the application packet and must be completed by the applicant's present school officials and forwarded directly to Lahainaluna High School Boarding Department.

Once your application is received and reviewed, applicants will be notified of their status no later than May15th, 2025.

For the 2025-2026 school year, the boarding department is accepting students in grades 9-12. Space is limited.

**LATE APPLICATIONS** are accepted and will be considered if vacancies become available during the first semester of the school year.

**COST:** There is no cost for boarding except for the normal school fees (student government, class dues, MIL athletic pass, graduation packet (seniors only) and optional purchases for the yearbook.

**MEDICAL INSURANCE AND PHYSICAL EXAMINATION:** Upon acceptance, all boarders are required to have medical insurance, a current Physical Examination, and TB clearance. The physical examination and medical insurance are mandatory for all boarders and must be completed before checking in to the dorms each year.

**HOUSING AND MEALS:** Each dorm room sleeps two and each boarder is provided with a twin bed, desk, dresser drawers and a closet. Bathroom and community shower facilities are located on each floor. Each dorm also has a microwave, refrigerator, washers, and dryers.

Meals are provided through the cafeteria. School breakfast, school lunch and dinner are provided on school days, while brunch and dinner are offered on closed weekends. Students provide their own snacks.

**BOARDER EXPECTATIONS:** Boarding program students will be required to maintain good academic standing at Lahainaluna. Every student is required to maintain a 3.0 GPA, if not, students will be provided with academic support. After school hours, boarders will be required to develop and participate in extended learning, team building, and community activities.

**DRESS CODE:** Boarders will be neatly dressed in school, at school functions as well as when they are allowed to go out to town on weekends. A detailed description of the dress code can be found in the Boarders' Handbook.

**SAFETY AND SECURITY:** All boarders are expected to lock their rooms at all times and to be responsible for their own room keys. There is a fee for a lost dorm room key.

**SPONSORS:** Each boarder is required to have two Maui Sponsor(s). Sponsors must be full time Maui residents who will be responsible for the boarder at any time the boarder needs to leave the school (due to illness, emergency, discipline, etc), spend weekends, vacations, provide transportation, or other issues that require adult supervision.

**MINIMUM SUPERVISION:** This program functions under minimum supervision and that supervision is limited during a boarder's free time, especially when off campus on closed weekends. The boarder must be self- disciplined, self-reliant and responsible.

**CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES AND ATHLETICS:** Boarders are encouraged to participate in any of the campus organizations and athletic programs. Athletic practices occur after work. Papa Hula is available to all borders on a school week night and the Boarders' Chorus is a mandatory activity for all borders, weekly, in preparation for the annual celebratory, La Davida Malo Day.

**GOOD STANDING:** Boarders in good standing are those that do well academically, and have no discipline problems.

#### PROGRAM COMMITMENT

When a student is accepted as a Boarder at Lahainaluna High School, the School Administration becomes, in most respects, the parent while the student is living on campus (dormitory). Consequently, there are high expectations that are required of each boarder. Our aim is to provide a safe environment and one that will enable your child to succeed intellectually, socially, emotionally, and physically.

- The Boarding Program is a work-study program, one that develops work and life skills therefore, boarders are required to develop and participate in extended learning, team building, and community activities.
- There are strict Boarding Department, as well as Department of Education, rules that prohibit smoking, drinking, or the use or possession of illicit drugs, stealing, gambling, the use of obscene or lewd language, vandalism, property damage, absent without leave, being in a restricted/out of bounds area, and physical, sexual, *or* mental harassment.
- Violation of dormitory or work-related regulations may result in loss of free time or a detention served within the dorm.
- Boarders are required to have medical insurance at all times.
- Class A and B Offenses as outlined in Chapter 19 of the DOE, or consistent violation of rules and the inability to adjust to the Boarding Program may result in dismissal from the program.
