

Conduct Grades

Conduct grades are used to communicate a student's behavior and citizenship development. These grades are independent of academic and effort grades.

Effort Grades

Effort grades reflect the student's potential, study habits, and attitude.

- 1: Outstanding Effort
- 2: Satisfactory Effort
- 3: Insufficient Effort

Ranking

Rank is reported using a weighted system. Miami-Dade County Public Schools does not utilize numerical ranking.
