4. Sian Chay Building Expands Charitable Causes.

On 28 March 2022, the secretariat received 33 (73.33%) supporting votes via the Member approval form to purchase the real estate of 208 Geylang Road Singapore 389269.

Property Development Committee and Chairman to handle and execute matters related the purchase of property and obtaining bank loans.

Trustees are as follows:

- 1) Toh Soon Huat
- 2) Lim Yong Guan
- 3) Lee Kin Hong
- 4) Teo Ngiang Heng

With the support of the board of directors and members, Sian Chay Medical Institution got the approval to purchase the building at 208 Geylang Road at the extraordinary general meeting on 30 March 2022. Chairman, Mr. Toh Soon Huat was authorised to execute the related matters.

At the extraordinary general meeting on 30 March 2022, Secretary Mr. Raymond Chua Swee Wah sought the support of the Board and proposed to set the renovation budget and carry out the renovation after the purchase of the building. There was no objection to this motion. The Board approved a budget of \$1 million for the renovation of the building. A discussion will be required if there is any amendment to the budget as the actual renovation progress. There was no objection from the members, and the Board accepted the motion. The Board of Directors unanimously approved the budget of \$1 million for the renovation of the building. This motion was proposed by Mr. Kenny Lim Oon Cheng and seconded by Mr. Yap Seng Teck.

On 20 June 2022, Sian Chay Medical Institution obtained 2 loans from DBS Bank to finance the purchase of the building at 208 Geylang Road Singapore 389269.

- 1) Non-Revolving Fixed Advance Facilities \$4 million (Fully redeemed on 27/3/2023)
- Interest rate: SORA in arrears plus 2% per annum (3.67% to 4.78% per annum)

2) Term Loan of \$4 million

Tenor: 120 months

• Interest rate: 1.85% (1st and 2nd year interest); Subsequent year interest at SORA in advance + 3%

After seeking prices for the renovation of the building, the management recommend to the Board of Directors that the budget for the renovation of the building needs to be increased. Therefore, on 15 October 2022, via WhatsApp Sian Chay Medical Institution's Board of Directors, we sought approval from the directors to increase the renovation budget and attached the relevant supporting documents for their review. As of 16 October 2022, 10 out of 11 directors (excluding Chairman Mr. Toh Soon Huat, who did not vote because he was appointed as an executor) to increase the budget for the renovation of the building.

4.1 The display board of Sian Chay 208 Building

Since its establishment, Sian Chay Medical Institution has received strong support, commitment and dedication from all walks of life. Among them are many pioneers, patrons, advisors, the general public, government officials and agencies (Ministry of Health, Housing Development Board, People's Association), Citizens' Consultative Committees, Town Councils, media, corporate sponsors, Life Honourable Chairman, Honourable Chairmen and Honorary Chairmen, supporters of Sian Chay Medical Institution, entrepreneurs, benevolent benefactors, performing artistes, volunteers, directors, colleagues.

With the changing times, Sian Chay needs to keep pace with the trend and expand its charity platform. At the extraordinary general meeting on 30/03/2022, with the support of 73.33% of membership, as proposed by Mr. Jackson Teo and seconded by Mr. Raymond Chua, it was unanimously approved to purchase the building at 208 Geylang Road as the headquarters for Sian Chay Medical Institution. At the same time, proposed by Mr. Kenny Lim and seconded by Mr. Clifton Yong, it was unanimously approved to authorize the Property Development Committee and Chairman Toh Soon Huat to handle and execute related matters for the purchase of the property and bank loans.

20/06/2022 Purchased 208 Geylang building as Sian Chay headquarters.

The strength of Sian Chay Medical Institution today is inseparable from everyone's bright vision and active cooperation and support, which has further consolidated and enhanced the strength and confidence of Sian Chay's continuous development; everything is not easy to come by, step by step, it is the hard work of everyone. Kindness and Brightness.

In view of this, the management specially commissioned 8 pieces of granite sculptures to be displayed in the lobby on the first floor, the multi-purpose hall on the fourth floor, and outside the heritage gallery. The milestones of Sian Chay recorded the contributions of benevolent enterprises and benevolent individual. In addition to gratitude and commendation, it is hoped that the universal love and selfless dedication will be promoted to inspire more people to participate in philanthropy and community welfare.

In an atmosphere of universal love and gratitude, we will work together towards philanthropy and community welfare, so that Sian Chay Medical Institution can thrive and continue to benefit the poor and sick. The benefits brought to the public can be passed on from generation to generation and beyond. Let us work together to make Singapore a city of kindness!

8. IPC Renewal

Sian Chay's Institution of a Public Character (IPC) status will expire on 30/06/2023. Finance Department has already submitted the renewal application on 28/04/2023.

On 12/06/2023, Ministry of Health requested some documents from Sian Chay. Finance Department has followed up on this request on 15/06/2023.

It included Memorandum of Cooperation between Theng Hai Huay Kuan and Sian Chay Medical Institution, which has been reported at the 2020 Annual General Meeting on 04/05/2021. At the same time after discussion, the members felt that this memorandum of cooperation's objective was very meaningful. It not only fund raised for Sian Chay Medical Institution, but also established a Sian Chay cultural exchange centre to promote Sian Chay's TCM charity platform and promote Sian Chay's core values, beliefs and spirit, striving to maintain, promote and carry forward the fine traditional Chinese culture, philanthropic spirit and community welfare activities. There was no objection, as proposed by Mr. Yap Seng Teck and seconded by Mr. Raymond

Chua, unanimously agreed on this memorandum of cooperation's objective, and further authorized Chairman Toh Soon Huat to execute the follow up actions. At the same time a report was made at the 1st meeting of the 84th Board of Directors on 27/05/2021.

On 31/05/2021, Sian Chay received a donation cheque of \$2,000,000 from Mr. Lu Jinbin.

Theng Hai Huay Kuan and Sian Chay Medical Institution signed a Memorandum of Cooperation on 20/06/2021. On the same day, Chairman Toh Soon Huat handed over a \$1,000,000 donation cheque to Theng Hai Huay Kuan.

At the 84th term (2021-2023) 6th BOD meeting, as proposed by Mr Yap Seng Teck and seconded by Mr Simon Keak Lai Heng, the above report was unanimously approved.

On 27/06/2023, Sian Chay Medical Institution has received a notification letter from the Ministry of Health that it has successfully obtained a 3-year IPC renewal (01/07/2023 to 30/06/2026).
