

Citybus Launches New Route 382 Express Service from Wu Kai Sha to Hong Kong Island East Efficient Cross-Harbor Travel for Commutes

(3 September 2025, Hong Kong) Citybus is dedicated to providing the best cross-harbor options for New Territories citizens. Today, we announce the launch of the new Route 382 express service for the Wu Kai Sha area. The new route will begin operation on 15 September (Monday), offering the fastest journey of approximately 40 minutes from Wu Kai Sha to North Point on Hong Kong Island during weekday mornings. It provides direct connections to Quarry Bay, Taikoo, Sai Wan Ho, Shau Kei Wan, and Chai Wan, making it faster and more comfortable than transferring three times via the train. This service is the most efficient commuting option for workers.

Efficient Cross-Harbor Express Service from Wu Kai Sha to Hong Kong Island

Citybus team has analyzed traffic flow through the cross-harbor tunnels at various times, leading to the launch of the new Route 382 express service designed for optimal commuting. During weekday morning peak hours, buses heading to Hong Kong Island will take the shortest route via the Eastern Harbour Crossing, while in the afternoon, New Territories-bound buses will utilize the Western Harbour Crossing, which has the highest capacity.

The new Route 382 will operate on weekdays during peak hours, with a fare of HKD 27.3. The earliest bus to Hong Kong Island departs from Nai Chung at 7:15 AM, taking approximately 12 minutes to reach the Tate's Cairn Tunnel Bus-Bus Interchange, allowing for easy transfers to other Citybus routes in Kowloon and Southeast New Territories. Return trips to the New Territories will run until 6 PM, with passengers able to catch Route 382 at the Western Harbour Crossing Bus-Bus Interchange, reaching Kam Chun Court, Ma On Shan Road in about 20 minutes. This service provides a direct connection to Ma On Shan, offering commuters the most convenient bus service between Wu Kai Sha area and Hong Kong Island.

As residential and recreational projects in the area develop, Citybus anticipates significant population growth. The new route is set to better serve residents of Shap Sze Heung and Wu Kai Sha, providing improved travel options.
