
Where will the Street Sweeper be in 2025?



The City of Stillwater's Street Sweeping Program

The City of Stillwater is responsible for keeping city streets clean of trash and debris. The Street Sweeping Program not only keeps streets cleaner and safer, but also reduces health hazards related to dust and ensures trash does not become a refuge for insects and rodents. Regular sweeping reduces the amount of sedimentation discharged to streams, lakes, ponds and other waterways.

The sweepers are out Monday through Friday, 6 a.m.-2:30 p.m. year-round. All streets are swept on a rotating basis, with an emphasis on collecting fallen leaves between September to March. Streets with curbs are swept first and those without curbs, as necessary.
