Anyone can put out a publication, the heart warming aspect is when that publication has enough individual support behind it to continue, one issue after another, on time. We owe you a lot of thanks. Thanks for reading our little issues, thanks for supporting those businesses that make us possible and, as Judy Garland used to say, "Thanks for being here." The Texas gay community is you. And that community has now made *This Week in Texas* number one. Because of your support, *This Week in Texas* has put out more issues than any other gay publication now in business in Texas.
