

Citybus as Designated “Transport Partner” for The Community Chest New Territories Walk for Millions to Support Northern Metropolis Development

(20 March 2026, Hong Kong) As a public transport operator, Citybus actively supports the Government's major development projects and infrastructure-first approach and is committed to strengthening transport connectivity in the Northern Metropolis. With this year's The Community Chest New Territories Walk for Millions taking place on the soon-to-open Fanling Bypass (Eastern Section), Citybus is honoured to serve as the event's designated "Transport Partner," providing complimentary shuttle bus services for all participants. On the event day, Citybus will also deploy nearly 100 colleagues to join the charity walk, joining hands in this meaningful cause to help those in need.

Citybus will provide outbound and return shuttle bus services on 22 March 2026 for Walk for Millions participants, connecting Fanling town with the event venue. For outbound journeys, participants must present valid walk passes at the shuttle bus boarding point during designated time slots and queue according to instructions. Each walk pass is valid for one person only.

Shuttle Bus Service (Outbound)

Boarding Point:	Fanling MTR Station, area between Exit A2 and Exit C
Drop-off Point:	Fanling Bypass (Eastern Section)
Boarding Time:	8:00am to 12:00nn (Participants must board at designated time slots stated on the Walk Pass)
Headway:	Around 5 minutes

Shuttle Bus Service (Return)

Boarding Point:	Fanling Bypass (Eastern Section)
Drop-off Point:	Fanling Town Centre or Fanling Centre on San Wan Road (near Fanling Station)
Boarding Time:	10:00am to 2:00pm
Headway:	Around 5 minutes


