POPULATION OF CALIFORNIA

BY MINOR CIVIL DIVISIONS.

DEPARTMENT OF THE INTERIOR,

CENSUS OFFICE,

WASHINGTON, D. C., October 19, 1891.

This bulletin gives the population of the state of California in detail by counties, townships or precincts, cities, wards of cities, towns, and villages according to the official count of the returns made under the Eleventh Census. The population of the same divisions as returned under the Tenth Census is also presented for purposes of comparison.

The population of the state as returned in 1880 was 864,694; under the present census the population returned is 1,208,130, an increase of 343,436, or 39.72 per cent.

Of the fifty-three counties in the state twelve show decreases. Since 1880 part of Del Norte county has been annexed to Siskiyou, and Orange county has been formed from part of Los Angeles.

The following summary shows the population of each county according to the censuses of 1890 and 1880, and the increase or decrease during the decade:

Twenty-five cities and towns have a population of 3,000 or more. The largest numerical increase in urban population is found in San Francisco, where an increase of 65,038, or 27.80 per cent, is shown. Los Angeles shows an increase of 39,212, or 350.64 per cent; during the decade Oakland, San Diego, and Fresno show large increases. The largest percentages of increase are found in Pasadena, Fresno, San Diego, Santa Ana, Los Angeles, and San Bernardino. No population was returned in 1880 for Berkeley, Riverside, and Pomona, which have become places of considerable size.
