MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENCY



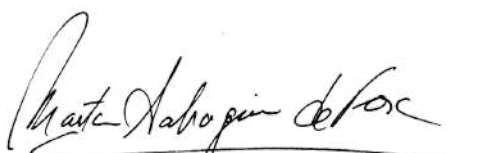

In 2013, with the purpose of providing comprehensive training to children and young people from the communities surrounding San Cristobal, Centro Fox began the Community Orchestra, Choirs and Ensembles project, forming part of the Bajío System of Community Musical Groups in Guanajuato, coordinated by the National System for Musical Promotion of the Ministry of Culture, within the national movement “MEXICO Culture for harmony”.

To date, it has a symphonic instrumental endowment with which it has instructed more than 250 girls, boys and young people in handling those instruments; has participating in high-quality concerts in important venues in the state of Guanajuato and promoting the participation of students from Centro Fox in national meetings.

We offer the population, especially children and young people, the opportunity to access an orchestra and special programs of musical training through a socio-cultural and educational project carried out in community environments, whose main axis is:

- Generating in students a desire and taste for music.
- Generating an environment of inclusion, respect and dialogue.
- Promoting values that forge healthy, sensitive and violence-free communities.
- Practicing a culture of peace through music.

We have 157 instruments delivered on loan by the University of Guanajuato and the National System for Musical Development. During this year various repairs, change of accessories and maintenance were carried out, which due to the time they were not used suffered some wear. 23 instruments were renovated and delivered to new students. There are 67 instruments waiting to be repaired or maintained.

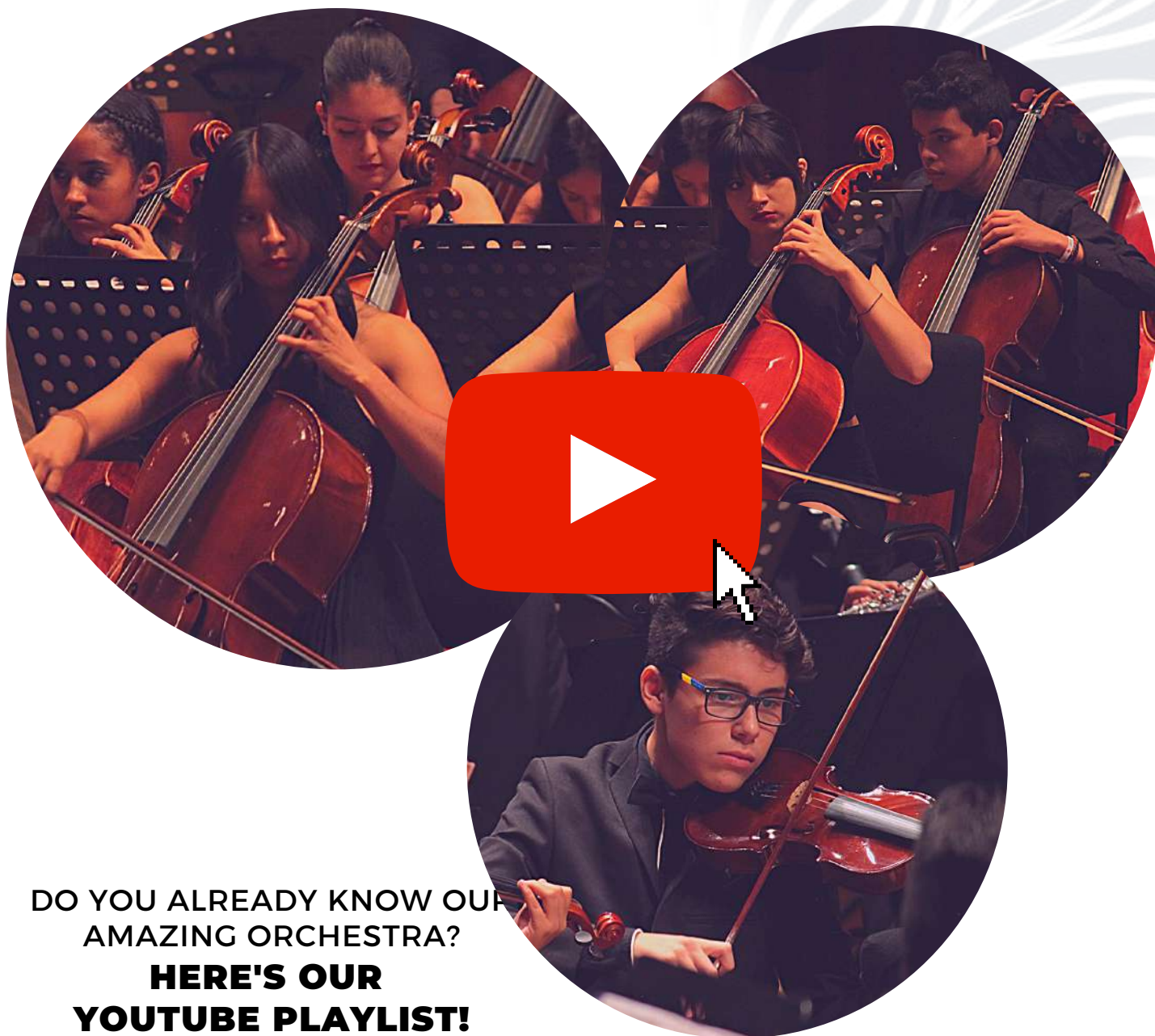

Through our social networks, we were in contact with our followers through different activities and challenges that fostered their creativity. As examples:

Vamos Mexico Foundation organized The Children's Day celebration at Centro Fox, in which we collaborated with rally activities and short film screenings.

In the month of April we closed the school year with the virtual modality with 29 follow ups where the topics of commitment were Education (14), Coexistence (10) and Environment (5).



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With the reactivation of the epidemiological traffic light, we made the 5th Call for our Leaders in Action 2021 program, in which we recognized all the groups that fulfilled their commitment made during the program and also selected the best projects to participate through voting in social networks for the grand prize.

This time it was a 3-day/2-night camp at Centro Fox and a visit to the Plazuelas Archaeological Zone. We carry out pre and post camp protocols.

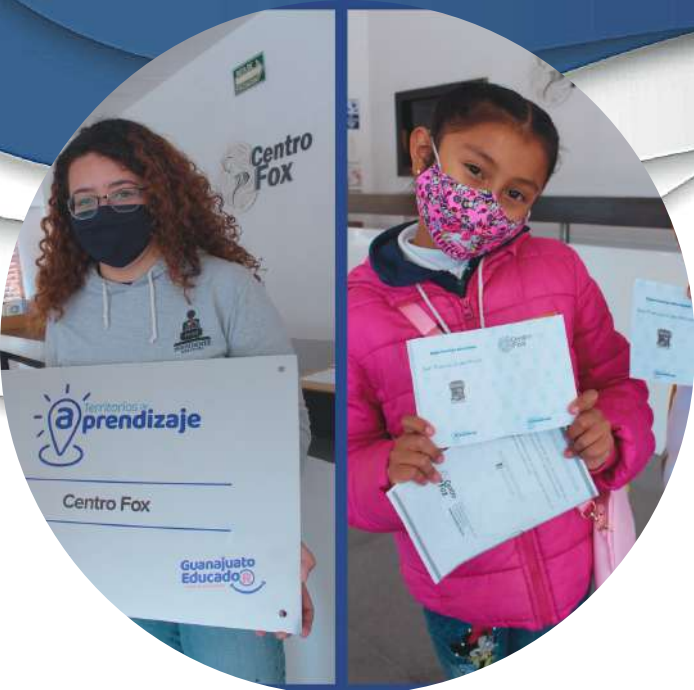


TRAINING OF PROGRAM STAFF

- We participated in the Annual Camp Workshop in its virtual edition 2021, where we learned about experiences of other camps in countries such as Spain and Colombia; about the sanitary measures implemented by the active camps in 2020 and 2021 (members of the Mexican Association of Camps) ; and we participated in different topics workshop.
- We participated in a training on building evacuation and how to handle fire extinguishers given by the Civil Protection Office of San Francisco del Rincón.
- We participated in the First-Aid training given by the Red Cross organization.

OTHER ACTIVITIES

- We carry out face-to-face summer courses in the months of July and August (when the pandemic went down); in this period we received children from San Cristobal community as well as children from other communities and from the city of Leon Guanajuato. With this groups we reactivated face-to-face visits. We received a total of 45 groups.
- We participated as speakers with the capsule "The citizenship role" in the 2021 Educational and Vocational Education Forum in its virtual mode, in collaboration with the Municipal Education Department of Leon Guanajuato.



The first edition of the Day of the Dead festivity was held. We had some activities as making crafts alluding the theme; the best catrina and catrine contest and altars making contest; and an exhibition of Centro Fox's altar for the dead.

We reactivated the **Extramuros** modality (visits outside Centro Fox) in alliance with the Municipal Education Department of Leon Guanajuato. Our children visited the Municipal Palace where they presented the Mayor their commitment actions at school.

We were officially named "Learning Territory", with the Secretary of Education of Guanajuato (SEG) support, in the context of the Guanajuato Educador program (to reactivate educational activities). Now we are part of the locations where great educational experiences are being held. Ours are the President for a Day program and open visits to the Presidential Library and Museum.

In December we concluded our annual activities with 74 commitments in progress:

- **17 of infrastructure**
- **18 of coexistence**
- **25 of environment**
- **14 educational**

We worked with a total of **2,317 children** and **young people**.

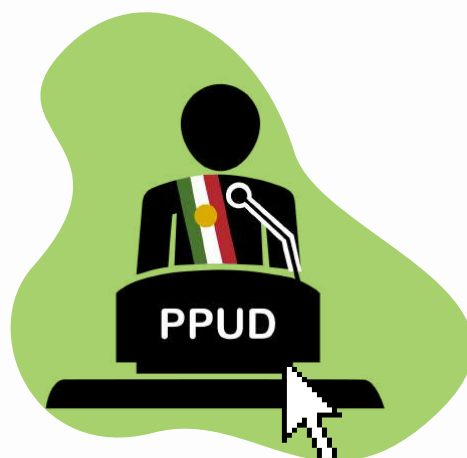
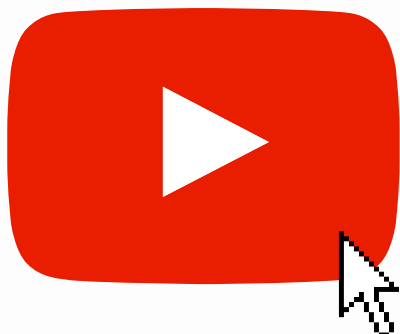

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VICENTE FOX PRESIDENTIAL LIBRARY

2021 was also a year of uncertainty: Travel restrictions, constant changes in traveling restrictions, quarantine, capacity restrictions, curfews... All of these significantly affected all sectors, countries and people.

Despite all the difficulties, the Vicente Fox Quesada Presidential Library and Museum managed to adapt to each of the inconveniences and health requirements. The limited capacity was also necessary throughout the year, carrying out hygiene controls in common places. But they were not only adaptations, but also great changes and opportunities.

Cultural institutions as ours, began to actively participate through digital platforms, social networks, and live broadcast and virtual tours. Thus, there was an improvement in the digital features of museums and libraries, increasing their work in remote mode.

During 2021 we had several decoration renovations in the venue: New tents, a library store and spectacular prints with relevant information where the visitors can learn about the most relevant corners of the museum. There was also a great boost in the use of technology, children and young people returned to using the library as their center for study, homework and other activities.

Respecting the control and hygiene measures, during the year different activities were carried out face-to-face, offering cultural, sports, and environmental, recreational and educational themes.

Summer courses were held for 3 weeks in the month of July, where 100 children from the Community of San Cristobal and surrounding areas participated, as well as 25 girls from Casa Hogar (orphanage) from the city of Leon Guanajuato.

With the reactivation of face-to-face activities, we increased the influx of children and young people to the institution, and with the application of health measures, it was possible to have and maintain a healthy coexistence and close communication.

As part of this change of activities, a launch of free digital-activity offer was made, during the year 2021; courses focused on the use of digital tools, such as Word and Excel for children and young people between 6 to 15 years old, achieving a capacity of 60 children distributed in different groups, always respecting and taking care of hygiene measures and control.

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VICENTE FOX PRESIDENTIAL LIBRARY

These activities focused in promoting Reading, Reading comprehension, writing, reflection and reasoning. They were offered with the purpose of strengthen and support the curriculum of the Educational Institution, instill the habit of reading and the use of the library as part of their daily life, in addition to offering support to students and opening opportunities.

A fundamental part of the library and museum are the users. Starting in 2021 and as a result of the continuing work in promoting the library through visits to the schools of the surrounding communities and San Cristobal, there has been a growing influx of users who use the different services of the library, such as loan of books, use of the Internet and loan of computer equipment, physical consultation of the book collection and use of work space.

We have had the visit of 36 monthly users, achieving a capacity of 180 library users from August to December 2021, months in which there was a greater increase in visitors due to the reopening of the Presidential Library and Museum.

Also. Thanks to an Alliance with the State Institute of Culture, Art Center of Guanajuato and the IEC Museum Network, we now have quaterly exhibitions in the library area, where visitors can appreciate different styles of painting and sculpture throughout the whole year.

- **IMPRONTA: Mujeres Grabando Historia.** This exhibition brings together a selection of the work of creators who have produced in the Graphic Workshop of the Guanajuato Center for the Arts since 2003.
- **UKIYO-E: Imágenes del Mundo Flotante.** It is a series of engravings made by woodcut or woodcut technique, produced in Japan between the 17th and 20th centuries. The original subject matter of ukiyo-e was city life, particularly activities and scenes of entertainment venues.

To continue increasing the number of users and visitors, at the Presidential Library and Museum we are committed to continuing to work for the benefit of the children and young people of the communities, covering 5 more communities by 2022 and that all the learning opportunities we have come to more students, young people and adults.



The SINED Centro Fox Distance Education Node has made agreements and alliances with the University of Guanajuato, the Secretary of Education of Guanajuato (CAEDI), Virtual University of the State of Guanajuato (UVEG), ICDL Mexico SC, Institute of Literacy and Basic Education for Adults (INAEBA) among others.

This alliance has yielded the fruits of having a physical space, technological infrastructure, training, monitoring, advice, training content, information, orientation, and educational programs with the participation of the surrounding communities as the axis.

In 2021, SINED managed to impact 1019 people in the development of skills of different educational levels through its programs.

Up to date we have achieved an enrollment of more than 250 students in open and distance undergraduate and high school programs, of which more than 20 students graduated during 2021. More than 80 adults obtained their basic education certificate.

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More than 170 adults and children has participated in virtual workshops given in collaboration with the community development centers of Leon Guanajuato and IECA (State Training Institute):

- **Basic Word Computing Workshop.**
- **Basic Excel Computing Workshop.**
- **Personal Finance Workshop.**
- **Children's Financial Education Workshop.**

More than 150 elementary school students from the community participated in the "Children's Strengthening Club" program, developing skills in computing, mathematics, English, Reading comprehension and writing.

We attended more than 300 users to the SINED room, who made use of the free services offered such as use of computers, Internet, printing and copying.

GUIDED VISITS

In the year 2021, despite the pandemic, we had a lucky total of 3,224 visitors.

The 3,224 visitors are divided into:

- **2,722 adults**
- **502 children**

The following activities were carried out during the year:



February 14th	50 gifts were given to those who visited us on the Valentine's Day.
April 30th	50 gifts were given to children who visited us.
May 10th	70 heart-shaped soaps were given to mothers who visited us.
September 15th	The facility <u>were</u> decorated with Mexican Independence theme and 100 gifts were given to visitors.
November 1st	The well-known and traditional Altar for the Dead was set in Centro Fox and we explained the visitors every detail of the San Cristobal legends.
December	The traditional Christmas Nativity was set up, with all decorative elements, we also had the exhibition of local <u>pinatas</u> , crafted from an annual contest among along San Cristobal and the surrounding communities.

Sundays are the most active days in terms of visits. We have a traditional horse show and children's farm. The great tent of Centro Fox, called Velaria is set as skating area. All these services are great entertainment for all our visitors.

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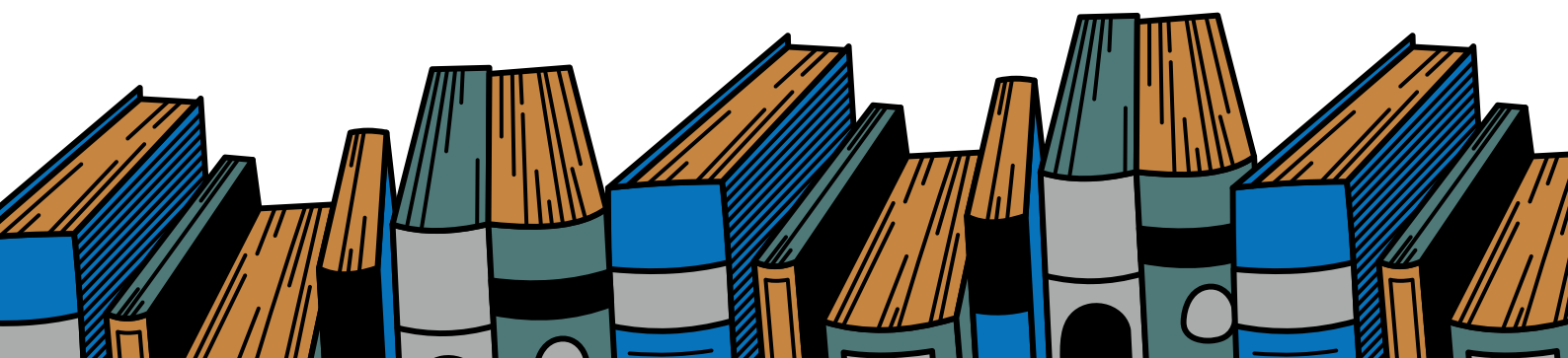


MEETING OF TRANSFORMING LEADERS WITH DIEGO RUZZARIN
