At Centro Fox we work to be the cradle of leadership for each of our visitors, from the smallest to the oldest.

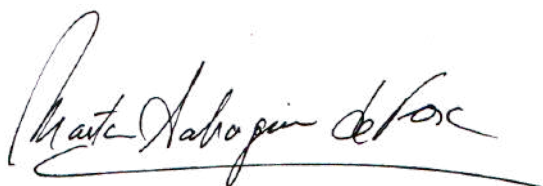
OUR MISSION IS:

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PRESIDENTIAL LIBRARY AND MUSEUM

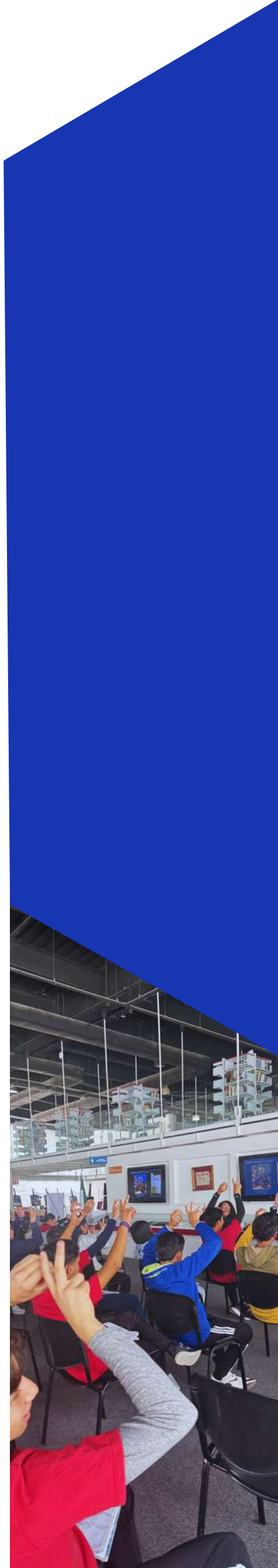
We are a space of knowledge and identity where the user is offered information and documentation related to the areas of Centro Fox, from leadership to education, Mexican history, national literature, etc.
