At Centro Fox we work to be the cradle of leadership for each of our visitors, from the smallest to the oldest.

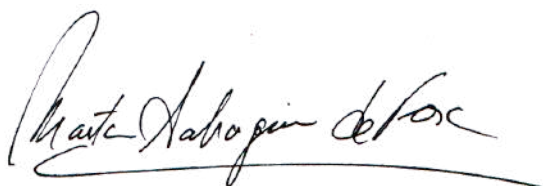
OUR MISSION IS:

ACHIEVED GOALS

- During the period, a total of **9 educational institutions** were received, receiving **9 groups** and serving **259 participants** in the **PPUD (President For A Day) program**.
- **Summer Course 2024** with **120 children** enrolled participating in: crafts, sports, workshops and excursions.
- **6 camps** planned with **Juventudes Gto**, receiving **74 high school students** from the municipalities of: *León, Guanajuato, San Francisco del Rincón, Purísima del Rincón, Valle de Santiago, Irapuato, Salvatierra, Dolores Hidalgo and Silao*, belonging to the **"Communities" of Juventudes Gto**.
- Trip of **Fulfilled Commitments 2024** to Mexico City (CDMX) with the winning school of the **8th edition** of the **Leaders in Action Award**.

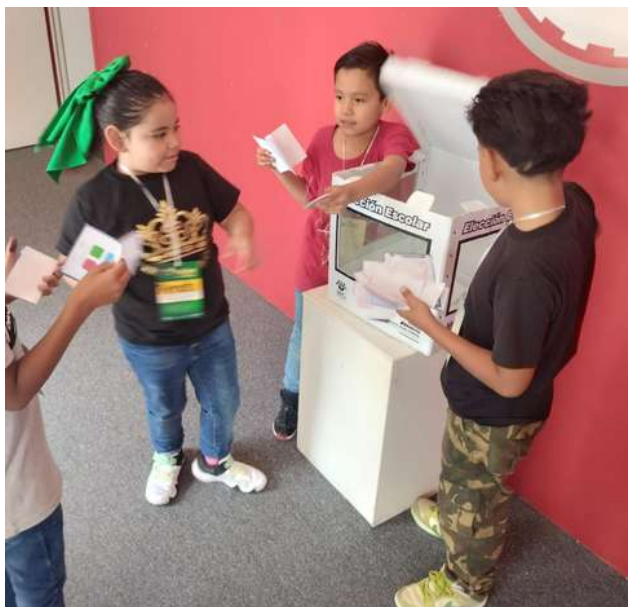

- **Children's Strengthening Club**
- **CAE UVEG:** High school, professional careers, master's degrees, continuing education and language center.
- **CAEDI:** Open High School and PRO SEG High School
- Literacy and basic education for adults **INAEBA**
- Training for work program.
- **YAAN University:** High School, Higher Technical School, Professional Careers, Masters, Doctorates, Continuing Education and Language Center.
- **SNEDI Room Services:** Access to computers and the Internet, courses, printing and copying.

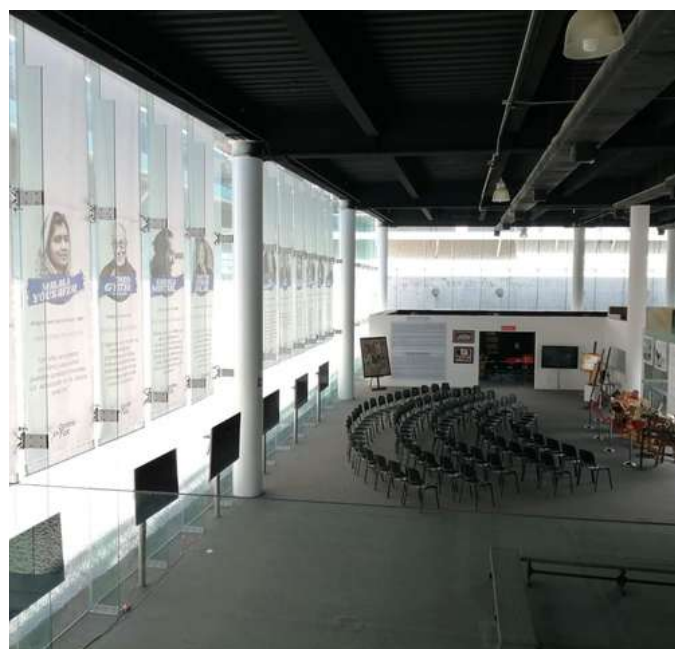




We are a space of knowledge and identity where the user is offered information and documentation related to the areas of **Centro Fox**, from leadership to education, Mexican history, national literature, etc.

We are the first **Presidential Library in Mexico**, which offers a retrospective of one of the six years that changed the history of the country, that of **Vicente Fox Quesada, from 2000 to 2006**.

Children, young people and adults have free and unlimited access to all kinds of library services and information, as well as recreational activities. Our bases are to **develop, provide** and **guide library and cultural services** to the communities in general, so that they can freely acquire and increase knowledge in all branches of knowledge.

EVENTS



- In September, **CreatiKids** was held with the theme of a Mexican fair, through board games. A family event in which **19 people participated**.
- We received **STEAM** training for Teachers, which will be used to apply the methodology in the workshops that are held.
- During the meeting with the director of the **Ignacio Allende elementary school**, the performance of the students compared to other institutions of the same academic level was mentioned, which is why he firmly believes that the students benefit from the **Library** and **NEDI** in the reinforcement of digital skills and reading comprehension. Therefore, this new school year we will work hard on the **STEAM methodology** using the technological resources available in the Library and NEDI programs.



The **Center for Possibilities** is an educational initiative promoted in collaboration by the **Centro Fox** and the **Department of Extended Studies** at the **University of California, San Diego**, through the **Mi Universidad** program that seeks to transform lives through education.

Focused primarily on supporting vulnerable rural Latino communities, this project offers **FREE high-quality COURSES** taught by **UCSD instructors**, providing opportunities for personal and professional growth.

The project encourages the development of key skills in areas such as **STEAM**, entrepreneurship and leadership, technology, science, and art with the goal of empowering individuals and communities.



With these results, we reaffirm our commitment to continue providing quality education and growth opportunities to the most needy communities.

JULY

Spring Graduation

- **192** students from **26** communities
- **7** different cities completed their formation

This graduation covered **11 courses** including: **Leadership, Business, Programming, Introduction to Computers and Technologies, Computers and Technologies II, Bookbinding, Art Therapy, Environmental Education, Nutrition**, and **two STEAM courses** for children.

AUGUST

STEAM training for teachers

- **33** teachers from **10** municipalities of the State of Guanajuato
- **7** different cities completed their formation

This course is designed to **strengthen teaching skills** in the areas of science, technology, engineering, arts and mathematics.



We start the autumn courses:

- **7** courses
- **150** students
- **38** communities
- **11** cities

Those who participate in innovative courses such as **DNA Science for Children, Girls in STEAM, Python Programming, Digital Empowerment, Personal Finance, Art Therapy through Journaling** and **Introduction to Business in Latin America**.







Centro Fox, in collaboration with the **Liceo Cervantino Verbo Encarnado** and **The University of the Incarnate Word (UIW)**, join forces to carry out an educational project that will benefit the **Community of San Cristóbal** and its surroundings.

Starting in 2015, Liceo Cervantino joins the international project of **The University of the Incarnate Word (UIW)**, also known as UIW, whose global reach has led it to become one of the largest private universities in Texas, being the only University in the United States that It has a **Study Center in Strasbourg, France**, and two official campuses in Mexico, including the **Incarnate Word Campus Bajío University**, located in the City of Irapuato, Guanajuato.

For more than 100 years the **Sisters of Charity** of the Incarnate Word have been dedicated to providing support to the community and their spirit of service has endured through education at all levels. They currently manage 10 educational institutions in the **Mexican Republic**.

The University of the Incarnate Word (UIW) based in San Antonio, Texas; It is recognized as one of the most prestigious universities in the southeast of the American Union.

Brenda Sofía Padilla Moctezuma (Eyelash extension)

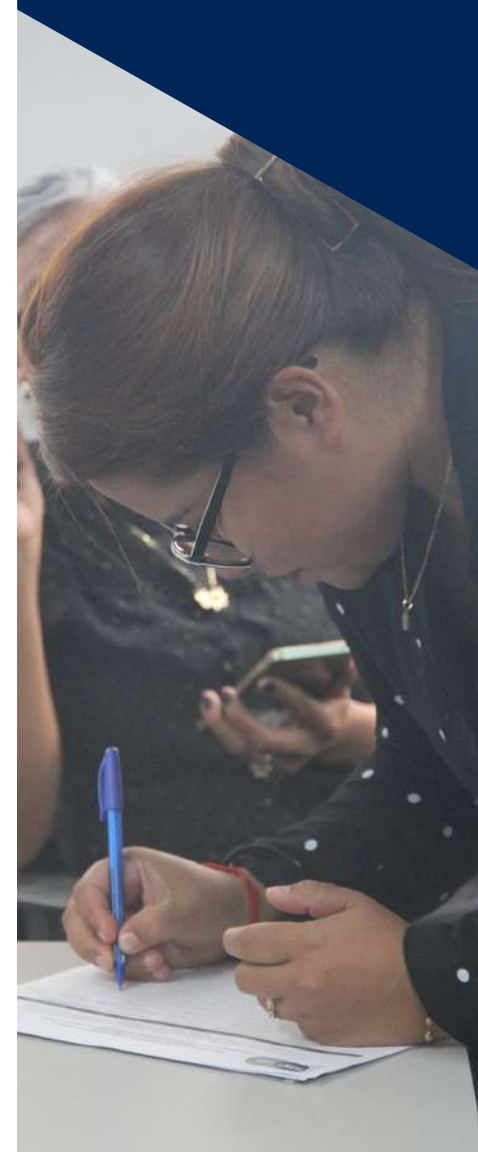
She took the opportunity to practice with external models during her training. Through these internships, she has managed to raise significant funds for the establishment of her own workspace.

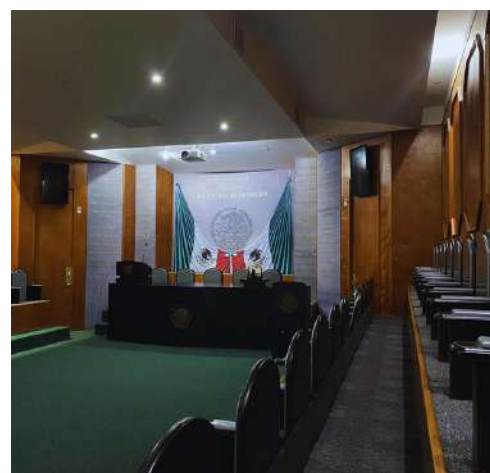
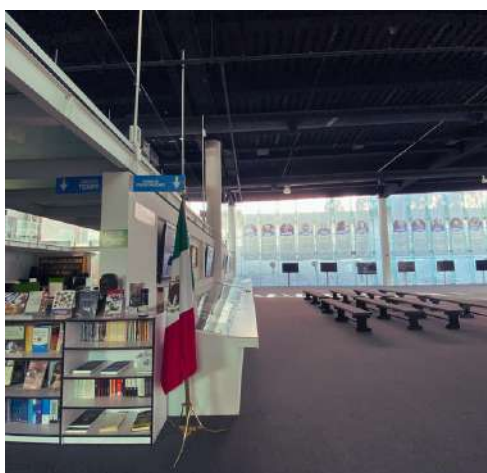
